ISSUE: The appellant is submitting this appeal relative to the following: Scientology materials, Scientology Religious service scheduling and other events in the chapel,

INTERVIEWED BY: Eddie Escobar, Community Resources Manager on August 26, 2015, A Facility Yard. Present for the interview was the Muslim Chaplain Muhammad Younus.

REGULATIONS: The rules governing this issue are:

- CCR 3001 Subject to Regulations**
- CCR 3084.1 Right to Appeal**
- CCR 3054.2 Religious Program Activities**

On August 26, 2015, a face-to-face interview was conducted with the appellant at the First Level of Review (FLR), by Eddie Escobar, Community Resources Manager pursuant to CCR 3084.7(e). A review of the Disability and Effective Communication (DEC) system on August 26, 2015 indicated that the appellant did not require reasonable accommodation for the purposes of effective communication. The appellant was given the opportunity to provide additional information and/or to clarify the issues under review. The appellant stated that he nothing further to add to his appeal.

The following are my findings after investigation into the alleged issue: Over the course of the year 2015, there have been many attempts to address inmate GOEHLER'S religious needs. Since May 2014, Chaplains Younus and Safonov have given all Christian Scientology inmates reasonable accommodations informally and formally. There were some questions in regards to which Scientology materials in particular from Bridge Publications (DVDs, books etc.) would be permitted for inmates into the institution. However, this matter has been addressed. Inmate GOEHLER has been told by Chaplain Younus that he may order books and books on CD's from bridge publications as long as they provide factory-sealed CD's and follow R&R policy for inmate property.

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In regards to the Scientology religious group scheduling as with all inmate activities, groups and other religious programming in the chapel, direct supervision by a staff member or contractor is mandated. Per the DOM each religious program is afforded at least one primary religious service and the Christian Scientology inmates have been afforded this entitlement (attached schedule). Even so, religious services are subject to re-scheduling to accommodate time, space availability, staff supervision, and safety and security concerns. During the month of August, Scientology services on A Facility were re-scheduled to accommodate Chaplain supervision for the five inmates who consistently participate in the Scientology service. All Chaplains continue to work diligently with custody staff to organize not only the Scientology schedule but all religious programs inside the chapel.

DECISION: The appeal is **PARTIALLY GRANTED** in which inmate GOEHLER is able to purchase publications from Bridge Publications permitting R&R policy for inmate property is followed. However, at this time the Christian Scientology service will only have one primary service due to staff availability. Inmates GOEHLER'S appeal to have three primary services is **DENIED**.

The appellant is advised that this issue may be submitted to the Second Level of Review if desired.
