On February 18, 2015, the Obama Administration participated in what was described as "A Conference on Violent Extremism" with one of the aims being to develop strategies geared towards creating improved socio-economic conditions, since these negative realities are said to be at the root of motivating disenfranchised – as if somehow it is merely these elements who are profoundly disaffected by a hopeless future – people becoming "radicalized," "lonewolves," and joining extremist groups like Al Qaeda, ISIS, Boko Haram, Al Shabazz, etc.

Now, before I delve into the blatant hypocrisy at this agenda and program, the important question for us to pose is: "IS THE UNITED STATES' COLOR-CARNAGE MILITARY MACHINE VIOLENTLY EXTREME?" Was the decimation of MILLIONS of Vietnamese, Koreans, Cambodians, etc., by the United States' carpet-bombings violently extreme, even as but for their imperial ambitions and the compulsory dynamics of their profit-driven system in expansive competition, this country had absolutely no damn business imposing itself in the affairs of these nations in the first place? Better yet, is the United States capitalist (i.e., High-Finance) white supremacist patriarchal EMPIRE rooted in and maintained by VIOLENT EXTREMISM?

Was the Great Depression, Jim Crow, COINTELPRO, the dropping of an explosive device on the MOVE organization – OUR CHILDREN – and the 2008-2009 Economic Recessions violently extreme? What about the New Jim Crow and those exposed to Mustard Gas without their consent during World Wars I & II? What about Obama's droning-to-death (i.e. DECAPITATIONS AND DISEMEMBERMENTS) in Yemen, Iraq, Pakistan, etc., while he and his daughters are off somewhere in colonized Hawaiian land celebrating Father's Day in safety? The blatant mendacity and moral hypocrisy of the White House, Pentagon, politicians, of all stripes, Attorney Generals, Judges, CIA, FBI, Congress, et al, is quite sickening for those who truly grasp the deceptive nature of this Empire's rulers.

- m Endemic racism, sexism, police brutality/murders, unemployment, infant-mortality, etc.
- mu Inordinately high mass incarceration of obsolete human labor (i.e.) especially those people of color;
- The 1%-er's monopoly of economic resources, media, governments, sciences, technologies, etc.
- ¤ Cutting off people's water, heat, electricity, leaving people
 homeless due to banks' foreclosures etc.
- m Economic austerity by the IMF/World Bank;
- m Weapons for space warfare.

In fact, extremism as a general philosophy and method of attack is a cornerstone of Amerika's founding and projection of its power abroad. Neoliberalism and so-called "creative-destruction" are but euphemisms for extremist policies and programs from the ghetto-hells of this country, to Greece, Italy, Spain, Puerto Rico, Africa, the Middle East, Latin America, Eastern & Northern Europe, etc.

Naturally, just as in the case of the term "terrorism," the word "radical" or "radicalism" - (i.e.), extremism or extremist - is selectively and conveniently applied and extended in order to emphasize and designate those groups/individuals whom a government and its ruling class, immersed in extreme and violently stolen wealth, are in political opposition to; since as the facts certainly bare out for imperialist nations, a group/individual(s) which are defined and labeled as "terrorist" in one context as for example ISIS, Bin Laden,

et al., in another, are defined and labeled as "freedom fighters" or a "freedom fighter."

We observed this in the case of Reagan & Company defining and labeling the "Mujahadin" and "Contras" as so-called "freedom fighters"; even as each of these groups were in actual practice terrorist-motivated drug-pushers to their damn core, and indeed were encouraged by their CIA-Handlers to deploy terrorism and drugs as weapons of destruction and fear.

It was the white supremacist (extremist) Director of the FBI, J. Edgar Hoover, who had the gall to define Martin Luther King, Medgar Evers, and others as "extremists" or "radicals", even as his extremist organization went on to do the same with regard to Huey P. Newton, Fred Hampton, Sr., Kathleen Cleaver, Angela Davis, Assata Shakur and the Black Panther Party, (i.e.), those individuals and groups seeking justice were designated and labeled as supposed "Black Militant Hate Groups." Swimming in his own deception Hoover, all the white male power structure, then and now, refuse(d) to acknowledge the reality that it is his reactionary ilk whom are truly the "extremists" by maintaining violently extreme socio-economic and political conditions -- until this time.

When those who are the perpetual and intended targets of their extremist motivations expressed via policies and imperialist dynamics rooted in white supremacist programs dare to resist at any means necessary, then it is them who are invariably designated and labeled by pejorative terms just as were Nelson Mandela and the ANC, Nat Turner, Harriet Tubman, Denmark Vesey, Marcus Garvey/UNIA, the Mau Mau, the BLA, etc. etc.

Just witness the recent tactical change of policy with regard to the lifting of the arbitrarily imposed "State-sponsors of Terrorism" designation applied to the genuinely progressive regime of Cuba, which was the actual target of the United States' terrorist practices for over half a century with the murderous collaborative aid of terrorism in Miami, Florida.

Now, isn't austerity measures imposed by the IMF/World Bank, the unequal exchange with regard to the World Trade Organization/NAFTA, NATO's forced penetration into Eastern Europe, Asia, Afrika, etc., an expression of extremism? Isn't the Western World's engineering of the global economy towards its super-exploitive dominance via neoliberal policies, extreme violence in terms of the deeply destructive impact inflicted on the poor and working-classes of especially the so-called "Third World"?

Yeah, right! These are the words of a shrewd pimp who perpetuates and lends total credence to the ruler's imperialist narratives on a regular basis while employing extreme violence via the form of DRONE BOMBINGS in Yemen, Afghanistan, Pakistan, etc. Shall Obama & Company "confront extremism" as practiced by white supremacy and imperialism? Don't hold yo' breath! Will the various imperialist powers (e.g., France, Japan, Germany,

United States, etc.) participate in a "Summit" to discuss their practices as THE prime THREATS to humanity, even as they have been at it this very month of December, 2015, -- "carpet-bombing" innocent people in Syria and supporting their "partners in crime" like that of, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Kuwait, etc.?

Hasn't the purposeful introduction of conditions of chaos via failed states (i.e., "creative destruction") operated to induce violent extremism in Iraq, Yemen, Nigeria, Mali, Syria, Libya, etc., as was certainly quite predictable with regard to the United States'/NATO's war strategy? Yes, these "fallouts" or "blowbacks" were and are deemed to be advantageous since the induced chaos provides for "fresh opportunities" to exploit and invasive foundations to be laid, even as their attitudes are that "violent extremism," which shall surely emerge as many are radicalized by injustice and oppression, is a "manageable problem" since afterall the rulers won't be directly impacted in any significant way.

In Afrikan ideologies and doctrines (e.g., New Afrikanism, Pan-Afrikanism, Africalogy, Ausarianism, et al) the term "radical," simply and quite correctly denotes and involves the deeply rooted SOURCE OF BEING; and is thus conceptually associated with the created life process itself, (i.e., Ra = the Supreme Being of the universe). On a social level, the term (ra)dical actually concerns and relates to transforming conditions – political, economical, cultural, psychological, FUNDAMENTAL LEVEL, as in UPROOTING slavery, exploitation, patriarchy, white supremacy, etc.

No, the term "radical" is hardly limited to an "extremist" or "extreme" out-

look in the form of religious practices. To my mind, the correct and appropriate terms that are to be applied to groups such as ISIS, Al Qaeda, Boko Haram, etc., are "zealot" and "fanatical" as these groups are ultimately religious motivated. Of course, the rulers will exploit what political capital and propaganda value that they are able to gather from the violence of religious zealots as a tactic to direct and shape the "narrative" in a manner which serves their geo-political and strategic imperatives.

In truth, to a large degree it's actually the extreme and indeed terroristic politics and practices of France, Britain, Japan, Sweden, Israel, Amerika, Russia, Germany, etc., which induces "radicalization" – (i.e., the attacks aimed at citizens or "soft-targets" are provoked by the TERRORISM of the EXTREMIST ruling classes screaming "terrorists" and "radical extremists."

Yep, it's one big ass devious game of "gettin' one-up-on...YOU!" as far as the rulers are concerned since they can sure count on the majority of their profoundly conditioned populations to react irrationally – just as Trump is now Amerika, as he runs for the throne of the Amerikan Empire – as they're driven by fear and revenge against those whom are the victims of many years of brutal imperialists' operations in which these spoiled "soft-targets" conveniently ignore as a result or their complicity with global gangsters of super-exploitation.

As our principled hero Muhammad Ali once aptly stated when questioned by the ultra-reactionary William F. Buckley, regarding Ali's remarks that the white man is the "Devil," the same reasoning applies with regard to referring to those whom rule the world, by the term "terrorists:"

> "Elijah Muhammad didn't teach Blacks to hate white people. You, whites, taught Blacks to hate white people by your Devilish ways."

I assume by this time that you've probably figured out that "I'M RADICAL" to my New Afrikan core. It was my political and spiritual evolution as well as the extreme and indeed violent conditions which my folks suffer (e.g., ghetto-hells, police brutality and the outright murder of innocent Blacks, deep poverty, racism, the New Jim Crow permanent unemployment, emotional and psychological torture – as in the case of Security Housing Units which primarily people of color are subjected to – etc., etc., that "radicalized" this quite sane mind and caring heart. If folks like myself are deemed to be "extremists" or "extreme" (i.e., radical) for the right positions which we take in terms of intense resistance to white supremacy, patriarchy, militarism, genocide, super-exploitation, (neo)colonialism, etc., then we embrace this designation and label with tremendous pride.
