I know I have to work on communicating properly, because I been in prison since I was a young person and it's not everyday in prison you have converstaions you would have in the free world.

In addition, I am open to sharing my culture with you, and open to any questions you may have. I am Oglala Lakota (Sioux) and Northern Cheyenne. I am very involved in my culture and very aware of the Native American issues for freedom in the USA.
