I need to find me a woman. my Belgium-princess isn't going to work out. Can't blame her. I wouldn't turn my life upside down for, what I have to offer.

I got a phone list, now I don't even have anyone to call. oh well! maybe someone will pop up in my life.

They're doing bar check and weight right now. over on the 1300 side, which is behind me. so they will be over here next. soon as they come through, I'll be laying down and going to sleep.
