Got in a lot of birthday cards last night, but mail came really late. I'll respond to them. I don't pay attention to my birthday. I don't even tell anyone it's my birthday, so it passed by without anyone knowing. My knee is sore from running in that small cage. When I come back, I'll do some more exercising, and writing.

The Bureau Chief of Education denied me on this GED. I'm not done. I'm going to push, just don't know how far, maybe a hunger strike.

Try to bring attention to the FDOC's denial of educational programs, a clear, productive measure that allows inmates to feel better about themselves, while accomplishing something, and taking themselves in a more productive, and positive direction. That's the problem with the FDOC. They're 50 years behind time. It's time for change. And I'm going to continue to fight for positive change.
