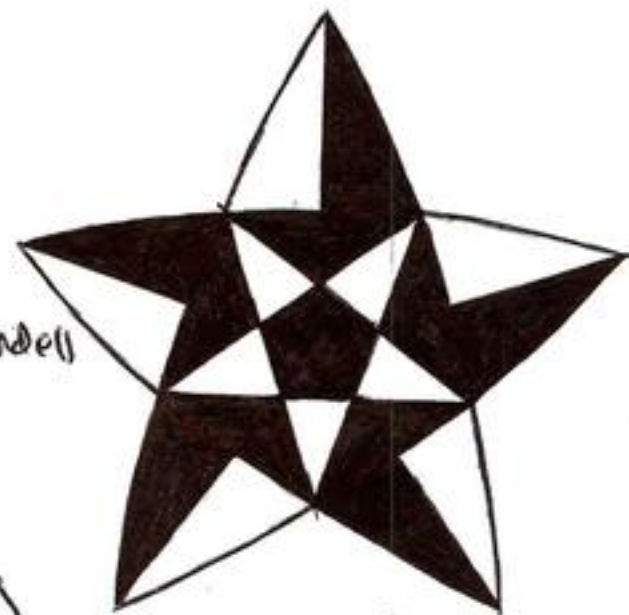

Christianity, Too, Promotes Hatred of LGBTQs

Christians who believe the Bible must believe Atheists turn gay,* that homosexuality is evil + must be hated.

It's not just Islamic extremists who hate LGBTQs!

Billy Graham's son, Franklin, has been touring the country, preaching paranoid hatred of LGBTQs to gullible people. In Pierre, S. Dakota, he recently claimed, ironically, that LGBTQs "want to take their wicked agenda + force it down our throats" - Freudian slip or projection, you tell me - then urged listeners to get in public office + force his wicked agenda down our throats, as Evangelical Christians have been trying to do regarding abortion, etc.
