RIGHT NOW I AM ON THE FIRST FLOOR IN A HANDICAP CELL (P-2128), WHICH IS BETTER FOR ME AS I AM STILL WEAK AND ONLY HAVE ABOUT 40% USE OF MY LEFT ARM AND LEG - I AM GROWING STRONGER DAILY AND HOPE TO BE BETTER SOON
