Things are getting really bad in our Georgia Department of Correction has lost it's foundation, a foundation used to reform criminals. This is suppose to be a place rehabilitation. To restore a woeful life. How can you restore someone to their rightful state of mind, moral and value to be fit for society. When you all are working the officers, you have to death. After they 12 hour shift over. Guess what some of them stay 14 and 15 hours because they have no relief for them to go home. They don't get breaks. We rarely have shake downs because the officers' so tired. Then you all have one officer over 192 inmates they are not locked away in a room. This is dangerous because you have all kinds of dangerous inmates in prison in this era. They don't give a d— about the next inmate or the officer. Some officers' have ~~even~~ been so stressed out they have had heart attacks. Even failed a sleep behind the wheel and crashed in died coming from the prison. I had a cousin coming from his 12 hour shift (night) at the prison he worked at. He was so exhausted failed a sleep behind the wheel and crashed and died this happened in February 2014.

Then everybody wonders how all these officers getting contraband in. It does not have nothing to do with their pay. I had a cousin who work at jail got caught up in bring contraband to inmates. This is what it's about when you don't have an accountable partner. Guess what your going to do those things you think you can get away with. That is how the inmates are getting drugs, cell phones and shanks. When the Department of Correction did away with the 8 hours shift. They lost their ~~identity~~ identity because their ~~more~~ officers to ~~use~~ worsen each other and inmates. Now you have more officers than inmates. So inmates they are not rehabilitating basically they

do what they want to a certain extent. Even some of them getting a chance to get their drugs etc. Things are not getting no better. As ~~the Department~~ these counties keep sending all these inmates; the prison is really over crowded. You have a lot of long term offenders in the women prison that are rehabilitated but the state of Georgia wants to keep on holding onto them for what we don't know. If the state of Georgia don't release some of these inmates that's been in prison decades and take the officers' back to 8 hour shift. Georgia Department is headed for a disaster because officers' going to start walking off their jobs. Because these people have families, other jobs and still going to college. You don't take advantage of people after while we gonna have people sleeping all over the floors. Because you all study stuffing more lifers, maximum sentences and then you still have the lifers in the systems that has done their time. They only people the state of Georgia is letting go is the addict who is coming back repeatedly. When something is broken, it's hard to be effective as you suppose to be. When you are fully equipped, you can do a better job. These officers' will be more effective on a 8 hour shift. Being a correctional officer is not easy. There are some severe mental health behind these walls, seriously.

When we entered out of our mother's womb, we became creature's of habit. Because we had to be taught everything. How to walk, talk and eat. Many of us was taught in different ways than the next girl, boy or family. I can remember my older family members would say; when their would be children in the family that range from the age of 2 to 4. The children would do things that would cause them to get into trouble. The older generation would say, for example; they are in ~~that~~ their terrible two(s). As I got older I found that to be a myth. There is no such thing as terrible two, three or four. Children mimic what they see and act upon what they are taught.

So what is going on with our generation of children today? Why don't they have no respect? No moral or value in life? That is what we are about to discuss today. Let's start with the lineage. Not all but some children bad habits come through their lineage, where they was taught bad habits at a early age. I remember two guys writing ~~me~~ me telling their stories. These stories touched my heart and made me sad because how many of these type of children are currently running the streets right now at this moment. The first guy started to sell marijuana at the age of 11 years old. Because his uncle taught him how to sell. So he could take care of his mother, who was raising him by herself. The second guy said he begin to push drugs at the age of 10 years old in the District of Columbia. He had parents that was together, happily married. But they was so busy with their careers. He was able to do what he wanted to do because he was mostly alone by himself. So he began to hang around older men who was pushing drugs. This guy said he wanted acceptance from his father.

father. So he started looking for this acceptance from the older men that was drug dealers; which lead him down a road of destruction. Because of his lineage of rejection from his parent but mainly his father. He ~~admitted~~ admitted this affect him tremendously. Sometimes bad habits can destroy a whole lineage or generation. I remember when I stayed in New Jersey. In this particular area, everybody knew that this is the S's territory. They ran the whole block, the drugs or whatever. No one would cross them because if you got into it with one of the family, they was teaching their children this mindset. Everytime you look around the drug task force was doing a sweep because they have caught somebody out that family selling drugs on camera. Well one of the sister got into it with this pregnant girl. It wasn't enough for that one girl to fight her. They all jumped on her. Well that was enough one of the sister stabbed and killed the pregnant girl and unborn child. Today, this individual been incarcerated since she was 14 years old. She is in a women prison in New Jersey today. I asked about her recently. My family said everytime she comes up for parole because she has a life sentence. The girl is still getting into trouble and fighting. This individual is still carrying on the family tradition even though she is behind bars. All this stuff came through her mother generation. Their mom did the same thing her children is doing. She was the one taught them those bad habits and criminal activities. So my question to all parents. What are you teaching your children? Why should have they go to find acceptance some where else. I remember growing up 1970, 1980 and 1990 things was totally different. I can recall when we had black and white TV's (no color.) At a certain time they would sing the national anthem. That was the end of TV. Now we have TV all night; without any discretion. Back then our parents, grand mother, granddad or whatever older generation we was around monitored what we watched, because they cared about what was going into their children minds. Anything that could corrupt their

Children they didn't want it to enter the children. All the staying
constantly in front of a TV and video game. In our home it was
like the No TV or video game during the week. School work and
Study. We use to be so happy when Friday came so we could
have these privileges. Plus we had chores seven days a week. If
you didn't do what you suppose^{to} for that week you don't get
allowance, no video game and TV. your punishment would be
to set down in read a book, learn something. All the hanging
out in the streets. We wasn't allowed to do that. We had to be
in the bed at 6pm school nights during the winter. Summer nights
when it got dark. We had to be in the bed at 9pm. We was not
allowed to spend the night at friends houses. Because our
family didn't trust anyone over us. I got to go to one slumber
party my friend ~~mom~~^{she had her room} had for her. I would look at how one of my
friend. Was spoiled How she got everything; didn't have to do
nothing to earn it. In she got to watch anything on TV. Cause one day
I had sneaked down to their house. They had a satellite dish.
She said let's watch TV. I said you can watch TV during the
week even when your parents home. She said yes. I said
what, not in my home. She said Guess what we are going
to watch (pornography). I was shocked. My other friend mom
had her TV with station only for children. Every adult station
was block through comcast. I look at it today. Her sister
child who got everything she wanted went to college but end up
in jail with a sales charge of drugs in Alabama. Which end
up messing up her college career. The girl was an excellent
soft ball player. My other friend went to medical school finish
with excellence. I ~~myself~~ had structure in the home but I let
past traumas affect my life. I never knew how to speak
up for myself because in my lineage you didn't deal
with nothing nor talk about it. After I get finish with this
writing. I am going to write my mom. Thank her for the
good things she ^{has} done to raise us. We was taught to say

yes ma'am, yes sir, no ma'am, no sir. this has took ~~me~~
me along ways. The respect for others. I think about each
time my mom wouldn't let us go to the pool with other
children because we couldn't swim. Some body end up getting
drowned. Everytime she wouldn't allow us to go to the ^{game} football.
At the ^{ends} ^{ends} ^{ends} of the game there would be a fight or somebody
~~gets shot~~. The same thing with the skating rink. Everytime she
said no. Somebody would be shot or killed at the skate
rink. When I was growing up. ~~when~~ ^{we} didn't have gang
member. We had rivalry (Lies) Donaldsonville boys couldn't
stand Bainbridge couldn't Bleckly or Coequitt. After events
someone is going to get shot, killed or jumped on. ~~when I~~
~~moved to New Jersey. I thought it would be better as a kid.~~
~~It was even worse~~ Oak Summers was different than
other children in Bainbridge. Our mom bought us Encyclopaedia
and we had to read so many books for the summer. If we went
at the library. We was looking for the book mobile.
Oh my God chastisement. We use to get serious whipping back
then. Call the police. what police. when they come. They
tell you if you don't listen to your mom or dad. We have
a place for you it call formatory school (which juvenile hall.)
Every child was scared of that place back then. Now a days.
Children shooting, drinking, having threesomes, raping, robbing, selling
drugs and running ^{the streets} ~~the~~ all times of night. If you call the
Police all kinds of foolishness happen more. Children call
the police on you. your going to jail. Basically the laws
of the land is running the homes. A lot of parents has
gotten too relax because they don't want to come to jail.
A lot of the ~~people~~ older generation in the community is
teaching the children bad habits that is leading to a road
of destruction. School is not school no more a lot of
teachers are teaching these children bad habits that leads

to destruction. A lot of parents are teaching their children things that lead to destruction. On 20/20 had a segment where they was talking about parents teaching their children to shoot a gun at a early age. The youngest was 9 years old. They said it was a clause in the law that ~~specific~~ wasn't specific. who in their right mind would put any weapon in a child hand. you are teaching your child to be the ^{next} murdered ~~child~~ Look at that boy in that ~~Connecticut~~ shooting that killed all those innocent babies. His mom use to take him hunting all the time, he became a expert shooter. Children see things on TV that nobody is monitoring. So they see thing get curious begin to wonder hey can I get away with that. That seems to be fun. Even down to our vided games. my mom didn't let us play violent vided games. Look at the one ^{of} the killer kids who killed his mom and shot his ~~dad~~ dad in the head because they didn't want him playing violent vided games. ^{They} Had took them from him. So he went in fired the games, where they was locked up in the gun cabinet. For ^{the} pay back of them taking his game. He shot them. His dad lived to tell the story. We all are the ~~epitome~~ epitome of our children. Parents, citizen, teachers and government (police, sheriiff) this everybody stopping ground. Children are everywhere you go. In new Jersey we had a curfew 10pm for all teenagers. I don't understand how these children are free to run the streets. ~~One of the things~~ ^{For In this generations} Parents are not allowed

to chastise any more. Everything has turned into child abuse. ^{The Government has} put fear in the parents heart.

~~Now~~ Now when children are out of control. The state want to follow our children has a behavioral disorder. Especially in our black community. The parent can't

chastise our children and stir them in the right direction. But the state government can abuse our children in

the foster care system, ^{and} schools. For me to hear that some children are worse off upon leaving foster care. They have ^{been} sexual assaulted and mistreated. That is sad. The next story sicken me to my stomach. How

can you experiment on child like they are nothing. Everything ^{David} was doing in the article was not a behavioral problem. This is a child who is putting up a fight because he is tired of being physically and mentally abuse. I felt he pelted the other students because he was being laughed ~~at~~ ^{at} and they said he

shoved a school police officer. The people was restraining David like he was an animal. This happen to David 11 times for a total of 63 minutes. How could anyone allow this school for behavioral disorder even exist. One baby hung himself. Let's cover this story. David punched and kicked and spat on his teacher. He knocked over furniture.

He poked a hole in a classroom wall. He pelted other students with stones, and shoved a school police officer. At the age of 7 David was too much for his teachers to handle. So they decided to send him to

a special program - unique to Georgia called a psychoeducational school. Georgia public schools assign a vastly disproportionate number of African American students to psychoeducational programs, segregating them not just by disability but also by race. Black children from the majority

at programs, segregating them not just by disability.
Where teachers restrained children with dog leashes,
It was a parent who went to jail for putting a dog
leash on a child, so ⁱⁿ give the State of Georgia teachers
the right to abuse a child and treat them inhuman.
but don't go to jail. The ~~place~~ ^{School} is where psychologists
person perform performed behavioral experiments on
troubled students and where chronically disruptive
students spent time in solitary confinements, locked in
rooms with bars, over the window. In one such room
euphemotically called a time out area a 14 year old
boy hanged himself. This was so many parents in prison
for abuse. They didn't get a chance to raise their own
children. The ones that was guilty the State of Georgia.
They didn't have no mercy own their parents. But it's
OK for teachers to experience and abuse children.
Not come to prison. Who ever created the program
and the people work under them needs to be locked up in prison with me.
To me this is ~~sickening~~ ^{to stomach} for these babies to go through
the trauma. Let's talk a little more about the
Student David. When they done shipped him around
the school system like he some rejected trash nobody
wants. Seven year old David ^{was} not allowed back in
school. He works at home on assignment (a Cobb
County school report once described the boy disruptive
and assaultive. Restrained David for running around
the classroom. yelling falling out on the floor, making
noises. During the four minutes she held him down.
David had emotional behavior disorder. David twice
kicked her in the head, tried to bite her left arm and
spat on her clothes. She said she sustained head ache
that lasted several hours. first of all this little has been
restrained on dog ~~time~~ ^{boy David} least 11 times for a total of
le 3 minutes. The baby didn't know what was

going to happen next. Really I am upset about this because it could have been my child, niece or nephew. These children don't have a behavioral problems. The adults do in this case. What have been wrong with setting down waying little David. What is going on with you, Sweetie? What's going on at home? Instead because this is African American child. You want to stereotype as a violent individual. Not all African American are violent. This shows that ~~society~~ ^{the} government can do what they want to our children. Get away with it in Georgia.

Then ~~the~~ ^{there} was another story two paraprofessionals at Rockdale County's School at Rockdale County's Shoal Creek Elementary School have been fired after a woman said her grandson's teacher left the 5 year old boy suspended by his belt from a chalkboard as punishment. ~~That~~ ^{is} ~~happen~~ ^{just} to them. They was just fired. Really. In this baby was a special needs child (disabled). Then there was story in the paper where a 11 year old ^{child} jumped on 4 year old student. Was banging the child head on the toilet. Six year old was injured taken to the hospital. The 11 year old is being charged with false imprisonment etc. When I read this. Immediately alarm went off. This child is not a problems student. He telling what this child had been watching on TV. This individual child is ~~not~~ mimic something. He or she ~~say~~ ^{saw} in a movie ^{at home}. Sometimes you can't even let some children watch wrestling because they are going to mimic what they see. This happen in Florida a little boy was mimic ^{ing} what he seen on wrestling in killed his ~~sibling~~ ^{sibling} & sibling. It was ruled ^{as} accident. In society and our government more focus on locking the parent away and lock all the children away. Lock, Lock, Lock, Lock, and lock. I am firm believer that there is a root cause to everything. People needs to stop treating the symptoms. Starting ~~at~~ ^{treating} the root. So the problem can be corrected. So many times we use that word don't

do this or that. But then the parents, school teacher, police, and government do the same thing they tell others not to do. Many of you are enabling the teenagers to do wrong by teaching them, or saying it's ok to do what you want. We got to stop being hypocritical nation where we as adults have to practice what we preach. We want our children to right ^{do the thing} but we do the very things you tell them not to do. Are we encourage ^{ING} bad habits to be done by them. In America, our nation focus on some of the most foolish things sometimes. Like the bathroom situation with the transgender children. I can pick out some many things that are important that needs more focus. People stealing from our children schools. Just to name one situation Atlanta Charter school to close after alleged theft. A troubled Atlanta Charter school will close at the end of this school year, the victim of alleged theft by the school's founder and mismanagement. Our children safety in schools, ^{and} foster care, our children getting ~~good~~ an education. We got to become examples to our children.
