This letter is directed to
your attention because given your official
position at Quik Trip Corporation, me and
others believe that the serious implications
concerning racist and insensitive comments,
made by the lawyers who represents you
in the above-referenced lawsuit warrants
your personal knowledge and involvement
in addressing.

THE RACIST COMMENTS AT ISSUE WERE OVERHEARD DURING A TELEPHONE CALL MADE ON MY BEHALF TO YOUR COUNSEL OF RECORD AT THE PEAVLER GROUP IN DALLAS, TEXAS. THE RECEPTIONIST APPARENTLY THOUGHT THE CALL HAD BEEN PROPERLY PLACED ON HOLD, BUT IN FACT IT HAD NOT. THIS ALLOWED THE FOLLOWING COMMENTS TO BE OVERHEARD " YOU KNOW THAT QUIK TRIP HAS A POLICY AND PRACTICE OF FIGHTING ANY CLAIMS OCCURRING ON THEIR PROPERTIES THAT INVOLVES A 'NIGGER', A 'WET-BACK', OR ONE OF THOSE 'STANTED EYES' MOTHERFUCKERS...."

AFTER THESE COMMENTS, SEVERAL MOMENTS OF LAUGHTER COULD BE HEARD.

MY QUESTION TO YOU THEN IS, DOES THESE VIEWS EXPRESSED REFLECT THE WAY YOU OR QUIK TRIP CORPORATION FEEL ABOUT YOUR NON-WHITE CONSUMER BASE? AND DOES THIS POLICY AND PRACTICE SERVE AS THE EXPLANATION WHY FOR "THE PAST 6-YEARS" YOU AND QUIK TRIP HAVE RESISTED SETTLING MY LAWSUIT FOR APPROXIMATELY \$7,500⁰⁰ FOR MY MEDICAL BILLS?

The consensus among those aware of this protracted litigation is that settling this for the costs of my medical expenses doesn't just make good fiscal sense, it's the right business decision under the circumstances. However, the consensus doesn't take into account that you and Quik Trip Corporation may in fact employ policies and practices that are not publicly known.
