## Ongoing fightback vs anti-worker law

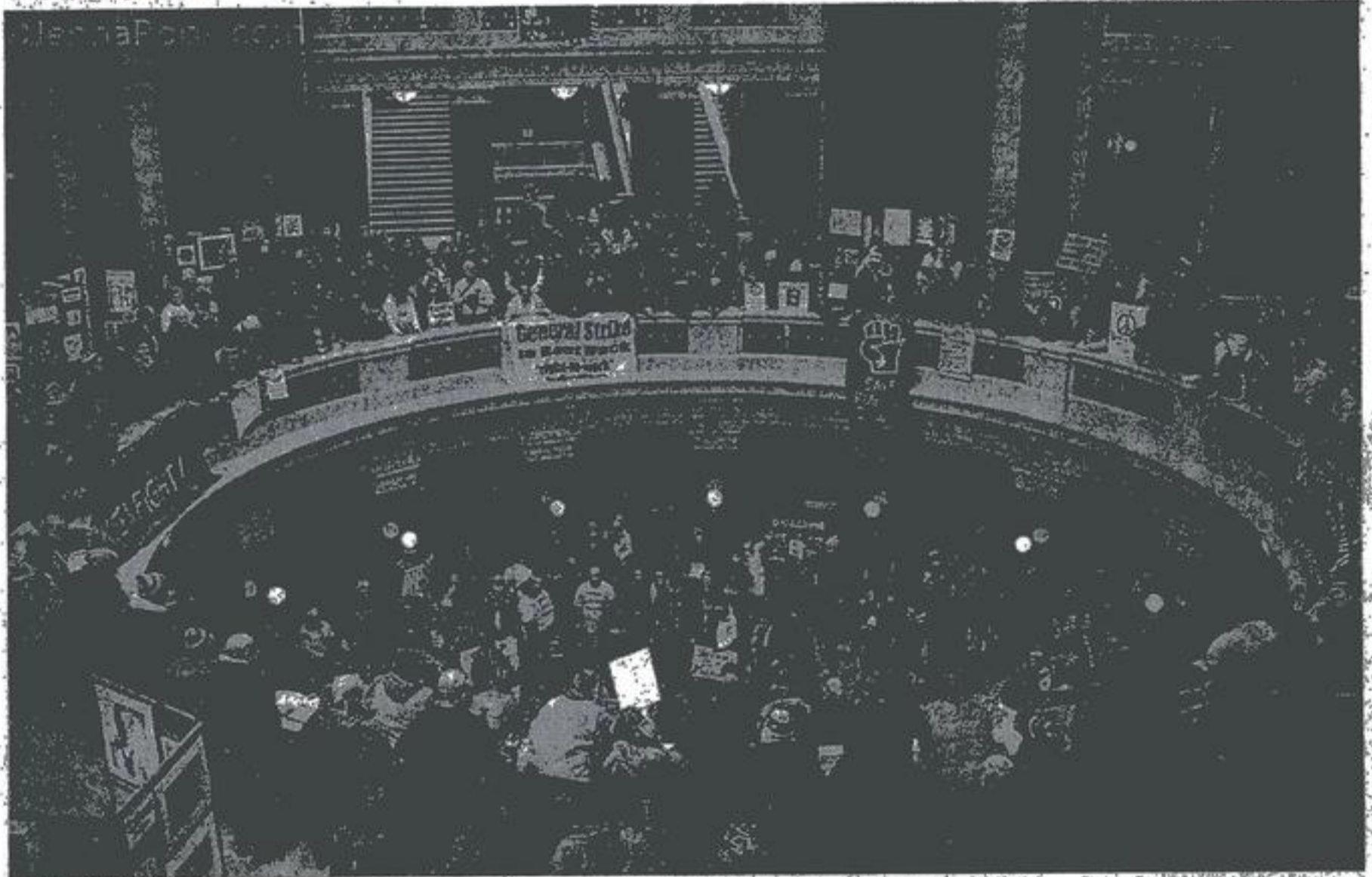

Despite overwhelming public opposition, Wisconsin Gov. Scott Walker signed a racist, anti-worker, right-to-work-for-less bill on March 9. It went into effect immediately. The RTW bill stipulates that workers aren't required to pay union dues but still have to be represented

In late February and early March, thousands came out to protest against RTW in Madison in freezing weather at numerous rallies and other actions sponsored by the Wisconsin AFL-CIO and the "Defeat 'Right To Work' in Wisconsin" coalition.
