If you are reading this Jamie, I'd like to hear about your christmas. What did you get? My aunt runs my facebook page now, her name is cindy. I just learned that she took down her own facebook page so you can contact me privately at my facebook page. Just type in my name, Robert Pezzeca, & it should go right there I think.

Anyway, what else is going on? People here are in a panic. The state has decided to shut down 2 prisons this year. They have over 24 of them, closing 2 wont hurt them. There are so many men in here for parole violations, they are not violent criminals, they are drug addicts, drugs users, there is a guy on my block who refused to pay child support, so they violated his parole and told him to finish his sentence in here. He will sit here for another 4 years because he refused to pay child support. I understand he has an obligation to his child but in his defense, he told me his ex-wife is living with another man, his child calls that man daddy and he hasn't seen his daughter since she was an infant. My point is, there are thousands of men & women in prison for petty parole violations when they could be in centers, halfway houses, treatment facilities. Pennsylvania has way too many prisons.

So what else do you's want to talk about? Hear about? Why is it legal for the prison system to charge our families \$260+ for a 19" tv that they make? It costs less then \$100 for them to make them (they use an inmate assembly line), the inmates make from .19-.42¢ per hour, 6 hour work days. So why is it legal for them to charge 2 1/2 times what the thing cost to produce? I would have sworn it was illegal to mark up products to whatever you want, especially if you have a captive audience who is only allowed to purchase from you & no one else but you. If i found the same style tv for cheaper, it doesn't matter, I have to buy the one made by inmates. With just a 90 days warranty and if I want to use the warranty, they charge you \$70 for a "warranty fee". Has to be a scam. If you buy a tv & it doesn't work properly, you still have to pay the warranty fee. Sounds like a scam to me. Inmates build them on an assembly line and they sell them to us for \$260+. But I have no other choice so this is what I get.

Well I guess thats all for this week. Not much going on here. It's cold out so no yard): I love being outside so this stinks!
