You might not have realized it, but my mom & my brother testified against me, for rotten reasons, which you'll get insight on in my essay/memoir in Parental Incarceration, Routledge 2016.

I don't hate either of them, but I hate what they did, why they did it & they're not in my life. I wrote my brother, told him I forgive him — but he still didn't acknowledge the sickness of testifying against his brother (at my mom's urging) for a crappy deal, something even the Milwaukee Journal-Sentinel implied was despicable.
