Hi, how are you? I just got your letter today. Thank you so very much. I knew this list existed but no one would take the time to send it to me. Thank you. I also want to say thank you to your husband for not being so jealous that you wouldn't be willing to help a stranger. I promise never to disrespect your wife. You have my word& I do not take that lightly. You have some beautiful pups. My boss at work is out for the week so I got to play with the 3 black labs this morning for 30 minutes. we made a big play/training area for them in the shop so it's always fun to have the puppies there. Our dog provider is called Vet Dogs of America. Thats the program. I was told they are out of New York. I don't know if you read my blog all the time or if I should wait to send this to you? I must consider it. You sent it to the wrong address. You used an old address, can you tell me the address on my profile page on the blog? I thought it was changed to my current address;

is that on there or no? No, a few years ago, 1,000 Pa prisoners were sent to a Michigan prison, I will get the name of the prison they went to before I mail this. They paid \$1 per call for a 15 minute call to anywhere in the USA. Find out who the phone provider company is, once you have the name, you can go on their website & read. Just look for the costs for local calls. My brother bought a cell phone& when they wanted his zip code so they could activate it with a local number to his zip code, he gave them the zip of the prison so he got a number that was local to the prison& our calls cost 1.50 for 15 minutes. Now they are down to 93¢ per call. It's probably either Securus.com or gtl.com (global tel link). Check it out. I am 99% sure that they all have cheaper rates for local numbers. I feel for your friend T. No child should be deprived of their mom. We all love& need our moms, no matter where they are. Mine is dying of leukemia& I still need my mom. Oh, I did win my election. 69-43 the vote was. I am now the External Vice President of the Lifers Association Organization. My job is to contact people on the outside to create a network of anyone who is willing to e-mail or call Pa state rep.s & ask that they support the new Parole for lifers bill HB135. This bill doesn't automatically let lifers out, it allows them be reviewed by the parole board. A prisoner, Johnny Williams just died last weekend in here. He had been in here for 47 years. Thats scary JC. He was a juvenile lifer, he died fairly young, 63 years old. But this is why I fight so hard to help get this new bill passed& made into law.

Well I'm saddened to hear about T's situation. Another life destroyed& children

lose their mom. This helps no one. As time goes on, she will need more good people in her life so seriously consider doing the pen pal site for her. You know there was a federal law suit & the FTC mandated that every prison in the USA can only charge a certain amount for a prison call. I don't remember what that was but it was like 15¢ a minute or something like that. I used to pay \$11 just to call my grandmom for 15 min's when she was alive. You could go on the FTC website & read it or you could go on [prisonlegalnews.com](http://prisonlegalnews.com) & look for it. They did extensive reports on this & you could easily learn from that site. This was 2-3 years ago I believe. All states must comply with the FTC ruling, it is a law now. They used to be able to charge whatever they wanted, from pennies to \$5 a minute. Some places did but those days are over. I hope you figure it out. You tell you aunt that a lifer told you that puppies in prison is better then anything except men & women in prison together. A dog, even if you are not the handler, just seeing it, or petting it, it brightens your day. I have seen men in here who have 40 years in, hateful miserable oldhead black guys who despise whites, but they go to the white guy & say, can I pet the dog, it's my first time seeing a dog since I was 16 (he is not in his 70's) his face lit up like a kid at christmas when he was told yes he can pet the dog & the dog starts licking his face. Dogs change the atmosphere in here. We love them & we appreciate them & people like your aunt who help make this possible. The prison that 1,000 Pa prisoners went to was called, I'll spell it wrong Muskegeon. I'm sure you know what I'm talking about. I can't get involved with the program but I go to see the puppies every morning on my way to work (gotta earn my 20¢ an hour, I got a pay raise, went from 19¢ to 20¢ an hour, terrible how they rob us). But 4 more pups are coming in 4 days. I'm excited to see them. All will be labs, 3 black & 1 yellow. Look on my facebook page, Robert Pezzeca. My aunt cindy put the photo of me on it with a tiny yellow lab, Me & Rafter. Show it to your aunt & tell her this is the joy she helps bring to us. I loved that little pup. I am 100% fine with this JC. As long as I can continue to hear from you, this is fine. Tell me why you went to CA, where you went & how was it? Well I think I'll let you go now. Gotta try to call my mom. I try every day when I can afford it. She doesn't always answer though. She sleeps 18-20 hours a day. I am terrified that one day I will miss a call & then she'll be gone & I wont have a mom to call anymore. I am afraid. I'd rather die in here than lose my mom. And it sucks that T's kids wont have that relationship or bond with their mom. Dad's are dad's, but mom's are pretty special. Are you a mom? No words yet from my daughter Krista. I haven't given up on her yet. Take care of yourself, I thank you & please thank your husband for me. For him to be okay with this, it says alot about him as a man and I am grateful. Your dogs are beautiful, I will enjoy the picture. Thanx. Hope you had a fun trip. God Bless, Ciao.
