After spending 18 years in state prison I will be returning to society this year; it is a very scary proposition - made even scarier by the fact that I am in need of comprehensive assistance; soup to nuts.

My former life of addiction crashed down in the form of a tragic manslaughter conviction. Those close to me suffered much more than I did. I was numb and far from who I was brought up to be. Upon entering prison I made a decision to attempt to repair my life, and have done a decent job. My main tool was helping others in prison. I learned about the law, engaged in programming and education opportunities, but found a new identity as a prisoner rights activist. My work is well documented on my blogs and numerous websites. Helping others fight abuse and seek rehabilitation helped me find myself - to work for self-realization. The work has saved me.

Now I am the one who needs help; a lot of help. I need to pay for at least six months of sober housing at \$150.00, per week, a total of \$3,600.00. I need clothing. I need a phone and transportation. You would have to figure another \$2,000.00 for that, at least. It is tough to ask for help, and my needs seem almost insurmountable, but I know I must ask for that help.

Please help to support my reentry. In return I will continue my work in helping others when I get settled. I will "pay it forward" and that will be a pleasure. I need to raise between \$5,000.00 and \$6,000.00 to get started. Please help.
