They have a wonderful parking lot to keep any car I could ever afford, and you do not get a few weeks free; in fact I have to put up a few weeks rent to get in.

Possibly you looked at my ad with skepticism due to one negative commentor here on the blog; don't be so easily fooled. My work in the prisons goes far beyond these "tongue in cheek" blogs, blogs which give a voice for the abused here in the corrupt system. My speech comes at a cost; I speak out and am abused for it. Please know there is a cost for that.

I just want to succeed and am looking for some support. A Sober House is an apartment building with folks trying to work a program of recovery together. That is why I am choosing to go there. It is not a halfway house or a drug program. It is a sober living environment where I will be responsible for my self. I look forward to it.

When you read something with a jaded point of view you may come out with a skewed understanding or perspective. Just know that I am a man of integrity today and have learned that I need to ask for help. It is deeper than personal gain. Help to lift a brother up, not drag him down.
