

TRIPLE JEOPARDY FOR CONVICTED FELONS

New York State has a three phase sentencing process for all convicted felons that no one knows about. Offenders get judged and sentenced three times every time they commit a felony and convicted. The first phase is when a person commits a crime and is judged and sentenced in a corrupted court of law. The second phase is when the person comes into the prison system where he is judged and sentenced again by everyone in the prison system, especially corrections officers who enjoy physically hurting or killing offenders because of their offenses. Even the other departments of the prison system, such as, medical department, corrections counselors and mental health workers abuse offenders in many different ways. And then the third phase, the corrupted parole board, who judges the offenders again for their crimes and punishes them by keeping them in prison for as long as they want. And once you enter the prison system, it may be an unauthorized death sentence.
