## CREATING A MODEL JUSTICE SYSTEM BRIEFING SHEET

### ■ WHAT IS CRIMINON?

The purpose of Criminon is to eradicate crime and to eliminate those factors that produce and bring about criminal behavior. It also has the purpose to reform the criminal justice system.

"Criminon" (meaning "without crime") is an international, public-benefit organization operating within the penal system to rehabilitate criminals and prevent future criminality. It accomplishes this by educating individuals and helping them to restore their own self-respect, thereby enabling them to become ethical and productive members of their societies.

### ■ HOW DOES CRIMINON RESTORE A PERSON'S SELF-RESPECT?

Criminon accomplishes its purpose through the use of L. Ron Hubbard's booklet, *The Way to Happiness*. Through a program of study and drills centered around this booklet, Criminon rehabilitates the individual's lost sense of responsibility and helps restore his or her self-respect.

### ■ WHAT SERVICES DOES CRIMINON DELIVER?

There are many factors which may have contributed to a person's descent into criminality. The Criminon program addresses these factors with a battery of courses. The keynote of this program is a course that teaches the precepts of *The Way to Happiness*. Other courses on the program include: Communication Skills, Learning Skills for Life, Successful Parenting Skills, Understanding & Overcoming Addiction, Recognizing and Overcoming Antisocial Behavior, Personal Integrity, and Improving Conditions in Life. Some on-site Criminon programs also include the Hubbard Detoxification Program, which requires that the delivery personnel get specialist training at Narconon Arrowhead.

### ■ WHAT TYPES OF CRIMINON ACTIVITIES ARE THERE?

#### 1) Criminon Correspondence Course Delivery to Prison Inmates

Criminon staff and volunteers deliver correspondence courses to individual inmates, grading their lessons and encouraging them through the Criminon course lineup. There is specific training on how to deliver such courses, how to establish delivery lines and how to fundraise to support the activity, which will be provided by Criminon International to those who want to start Criminon Correspondence Course delivery.



## **2) Criminon On-Site Delivery in Prisons and Juvenile Detention Centers**

Criminon delivers courses directly to inmates and juveniles inside correctional institutions. To deliver such courses, personnel need to be trained and certified as Course Supervisors and get additional hatting from Criminon International. Public who want to start Criminon On-Site Delivery need to contact Criminon International, who will then guide the person through the application, hatting and licensing.

## **3) Criminon Community Education Centers**

Criminon delivers courses directly to probationers, i.e. people who have committed a crime but have not been sent to prison, or to juveniles who have gotten into trouble with the law, offering a line-up of Criminon courses in a course room. To deliver such courses requires a trained Course Supervisor, plus additional hatting material that is provided by Criminon International. Public who want to start such a Center will need to obtain or arrange premises to deliver in. Probationers pay a fee for the courses they choose to take. Students are procured by direct promotion, court referrals and/or referrals from probation officers. Contact Criminon International for the application, hatting and licensing needed to start.

## **4) Criminon Training of Correctional Officers**

Training correctional officers on Criminon's successful methods of criminal rehabilitation is one of the most effective ways to change the "revolving door" pattern of crime. This is done by contacting correctional facilities and/or Justice Departments, enlightening them on the benefits of the Criminon approach to criminal reform, and closing them to enroll their staff on Criminon delivery courses. A trained Course Supervisor is required to deliver such courses. Such course delivery is usually on-site at the institution requesting the training. Criminon International provides the application forms, hatting and licensing necessary to establish and run such an activity.

## **■ HOW DOES ONE START A CRIMINON ACTIVITY OR SET UP A CRIMINON DELIVERY CENTER?**

Public who want to start Criminon delivery in their area need to get an application form from Criminon International, and will need to sign a licensing agreement. Criminon International will provide guidance on how to establish delivery and how to do fundraising and obtain grants from governments and institutions to support such delivery.
