**Who to contact...** Inmates who would like to be considered for Everglades Incentivized Prison must request placement through their Classification officer.

## Who is eligible?

- Inmates who **HAVE NOT** been placed in CM within the last 4 years
- Inmates who **HAVE NOT** received assaultive or serious DR's in the past 4 years
- Inmates who **HAVE NOT** received DC time in the past 2 years
- Inmates **MUST MEET** the prior established profile of Everglades CI.

**How to stay...** Inmates must maintain DR free status for continual placement. Negative transfers will be issued based on inmate behavior.

The intent of this facility is to provide a low stress environment to encourage wellness and healthy lifestyles. A variety of enhanced wellness opportunities will exist throughout the facility providing inmates with the resources and tools to build knowledge sets that will positively transform, not only their lives, but also their families. This initiative will focus on quality of life with life skills improvements, programs and education, recreation, leisure, wellness, and re-integration components.

## Are you ready for a positive change?

The first FDC incentivized facility will serve as a progressive housing unit that affords inmates the opportunity to complete their sentence within a population of like-minded individuals wanting to overcome their problematic past and be the change agents of their futures.

**\*\*\*EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY\*\*\***

It is the inmate's responsibility to provide the attorney the SECURUS contact number (1-800-844-6591) to set up an account. Once the attorney has set up an account with SECURUS, the inmate will be able to place secure confidential legal call directly to the attorney. Due to the volume of attorney/legal calls, inmates are allowed one legal call per day. All legal calls are to pre-scheduled through your assigned Classification Officer. SECURUS Correctional Billing Services: 1-800-844-6591 (Law Firms/Attorney's only) Legal phone calls do not require PIN, legal calls are not recorded, calls are limited to 35 minutes in duration, and attorneys are responsible for charges incurred.

### SECURUS PHONE ORIENTATION

WHENEVER AN INMATE SUBMITS ANY REVISION TO THEIR PHONE LIST, IT IS THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS POLICY AND PROCEDURE TO TREAT ALL NUMBERS AS THOUGH THEY HAVE NEVER BEEN APPROVED IN THE SYSTEM. FDC AND SECURUS GO THROUGH A STANDARD VALIDATION PROCESS TO ENSURE THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND PHONE NUMBER ON THE UPDATED PHONE LIST MATCH FDC & SECURUS' ONLINE VALIDATION SYSTEM. IF THERE ARE DISCREPANCIES, THE SECURUS SITE ADMINISTRATOR REQUIRES A PHYSICAL PHONE BILL MATCHING ALL THE TELEPHONE LIST INFORMATION TO THE BILL.

IN THE CASE OF CELL PHONES, VALIDATION WILL REQUIRE A PHYSICAL BILL AND MAY REQUIRE THE CARRIER CONTRACT ASSOCIATED WITH THE CELL PHONE NUMBER. CONTRACTS MAY BE REQUIRED TO ENSURE THE CELL PHONE IS NOT A DISPOSABLE OR "BURNER" PHONE, AS THOSE ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONTRACT BETWEEN FDC AND SECURUS.

Es responsabilidad del interno para proporcionar al abogado que el SECURUS de contacto (1-800-844-6591) para configurar una cuenta. Una vez que el abogado ha creado una cuenta con SECURUS, el interno podrá seguro confidencial llamada legales directamente al abogado. Debido al volumen de llamadas de fiscal y legal, los internos se permiten una llamada legal al día. Todas las llamadas legales son previamente programado a través de su oficial de clasificación asignado. SECURUS Correctional Billing Services: 1-800-844-6591 (empresas/abogado de solamente) Legal llamadas no es necesario, no se registran llamadas legales, llamadas están limitadas a 35 minutos de duración y abogados son responsables por los gastos incurridos.

**Waste Water:** The students learn the Water Program from Sacramento State. The course runs for about 8 months to 1 year. The students then are given the Waste Water Exam onsite and upon passing the exam they are sent the certificate of course completion and is now ready to take the required hours and become job ready upon being released back into society.

**CDL:** This course is given by the DMV (Department of Motor Vehicle). The students attend class on-site for approximately 8 months to 1 year. Upon completion of the course the students are given the exam by the (DMV). Upon passing the exam and being released back into society the next step is for them to schedule with their local DMV for the driving exam with a license in good standings.

**5000 Role Models:** Middle/ High School students come to the facility for continued motivation to stay on the positive track to remain out of jails and prisons.

**Gavel Club:** Toastmasters, international and Outside sponsors encourage inmates that are challenged to speak through debating a topic in a timely and professional manner.

**Creative Writing:** Volunteers that are Professors come out and allow assigned students the opportunity to express themselves through writing, by short stories, poetry, essays, and the exchange of reading material with college students to get their feedback, as to their thoughts this is all done anonymously.

**Zen Meditation:** Volunteers come and assist the inmates in mediation calming techniques with spiritual and ascetic discipline, a part of which, including breath control, simple meditation, and the adoption of specific bodily postures, is practiced for health and relaxation.

**Children of Inmates:** inmates and their children get to spend time together with positive parenting activities, which allows the inmates to continue the bond with their kids, while incarcerated. This program services are based on location of inmate housing. Example: Everglades C.I. (Miami-Dade and Broward County).

I seek opportunities to participate in programs and extracurricular activities to aid in my character, development and self-improvement. I understand the ultimate goal of this administration is to provide a clean, safe, and positive atmosphere for the men of Everglades. I will treat my fellow man with dignity and respect at all time. Self-Improvement is a journey; I am committed to the process.

**The following criteria's must be met in order to participate in the following programs:**

**CDL:** Must have a High School Diploma or GED, 4 years and under of being released. This is to meet the requirements to take the DMV required state board exam and driving exam to obtain the 320 hours with-in the 5 years.

**Small Business:** Must have 10 years or under of release and preparing in-class a business plan along with concept, and portfolio for presentation to the company or grant or of choice upon release.

**C.O.M.P.A.S.S:** 3 years and under of release from incarceration. This is a mandatory program and prepares you for release back into society.

**Waste Water:** Must have a High School Diploma or GED, 5 years and under of release from incarceration in order to take the state board exam, and obtain the 2080 hours of on the job plant training.

**Art:** Volunteers that are Professors come out and allow assigned students the opportunity to use their skills in expression through-out art work.

**GED:** Must have 5 years or under of release and testing of the TABE may be required to know the education level of the student.

**Poetry:** Must have a passion for writing of short stories, poems, and etc. willing to listen to instructions given and dedicate yourself to the class and the assignments given.

**Journalism:** Volunteers that are Professors assist and teach the students on better craftsmanship in improved writing and interviewing techniques.
