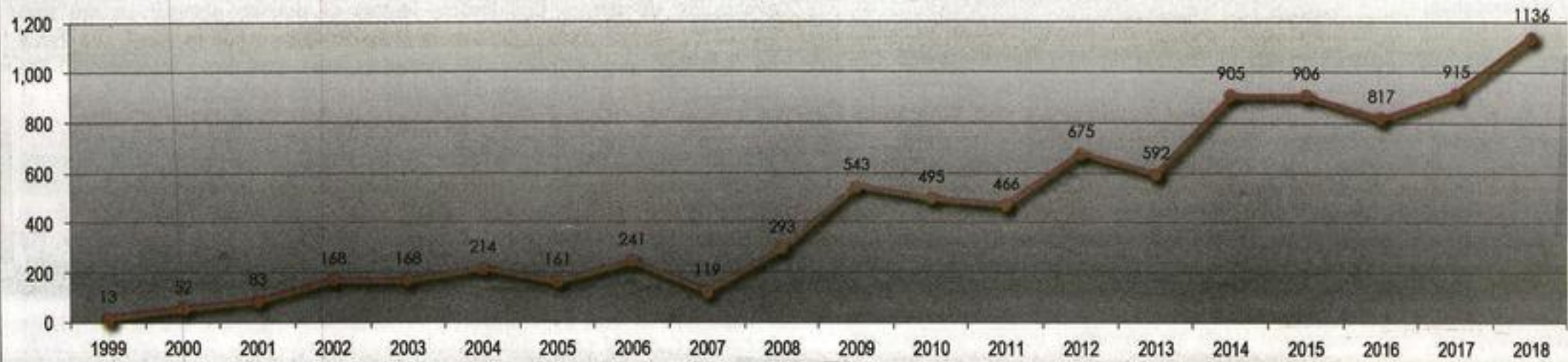
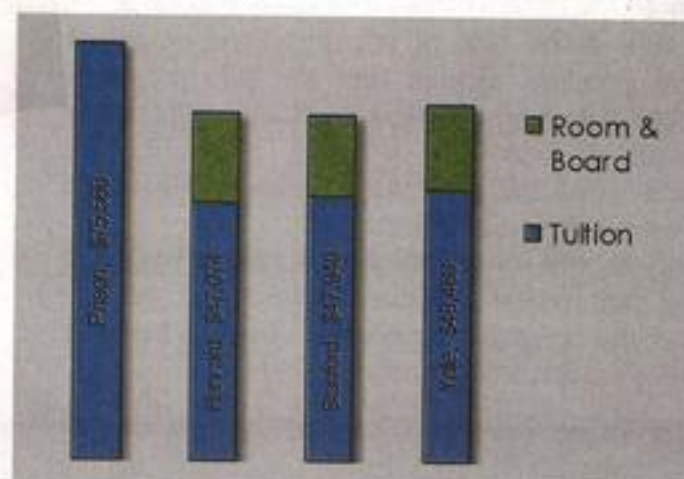

The average cost to house an inmate in one of California's prisons is approximately \$75,560. That's more than the yearly cost of a premium education at Harvard, Stanford, or Yale Universities. For an elderly inmate who needs specialized care and medication, the costs spiral upwards of \$100,000 or more.
