AUTHORIZATION FOR INMATE PURCHASES OF RELIGIOUS PROPERTY WITHOUT CHAPLAIN APPROVAL

The purpose of this memorandum is to clarify that institution chaplains are not required to provide written approval for inmates to purchase non-food personal religious items. Written approval for these items is provided via the Religious Personal Property Matrix (RPPM).

Effective the date of this memorandum, inmates shall be authorized to purchase non-food items which are listed within the RPPM from approved vendors without prior approval of the institution chaplains. This language shall be reflected in a forthcoming amendment to the Department Operations Manual, Section 54030.7 Inmate Personal Property Acquisition, which currently states, "Purchases of health care appliances, correspondence courses, religious items, and handicraft material require an inmate to obtain prior approval."
