The tablet also allows us to watch movies, read books, listen to music, play video games, and order commissary. But none of the services are free! It's just another way to exploit our family and love ones out of their hard earned wages.

Thus far, I am Corona free, but the anxiety of what may or may not happen is the mental prison that most prisoners find themselves confined in, and I'm sure those in the free society are battling with the same anxiety, huh? How are you dealing with this Corona?

Yes, I was around with the AIDS outbreak, and to this day, I still find it hard to believe that it was zoonotic from chimpanzees without man being the cause of it. I truly believe it was engineered to target the African and Gay population. But only when it ended up affecting wealthy Europeans, did they find a cocktail and/or so-called cure that would prolong life.

What type of screenplays and short stories did you have published. Why did you give up writing? Seems like with your medical retirement, that would be the perfect time to take your writings seriously, and make a living from it?

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My transfer to the Indiana Supreme Court was denied, and now I'm filing a Petition for Clemency. I cut grass this week, and I'm glad to be back working outside. Plus I love the smell of fresh cut grass.
