he has cold like symptoms, feels week, low on energy, has stoped eating or taking his insulin shots. Today I asked the nurse to check on him as i was at the window on the outside recreation yard. she went to his cell spoke to him for 45 seconds then left.

Nothings been done. 2 hours later he has not gone to see medical. shame on them! UTMB is the worst to deal with.

In 2010 I spent my whole defense fund to sue for a hernia repair operation I should of got without having to exauste my resources! just one example of many events of prisoner neglect in Tx.

Indeed the numbers do not lie!

I compliment you on your idea- a social awareness action, online petition would posibly get some attention!

We have wrote letters, filed grievances, even had anti dp acitivist file obsbudsmans complains. Only when HQ is made aware do they jump into action.

I remain repressed in solidarity for the cause.
