

On 06/10/2020 the California Men's Colony (CMC) Correctional Counselor III (CCIII) assigned to the Division of Rehabilitative Programs (DRP) requested that classification staff at Mule Creek State Prison (MCSP) review inmates that may be potentially eligible and interested in participating in the CMC Offender Mentor Certification Program (OMCP) that is at CMC in a level III setting. Based on prior interactions with this inmate and a brief cursory overview of the information contained in the Strategic Offender Management System (SOMS) and Electronic Records Management System (ERMS) I believe that inmate GOEHLER (K77832) may be a successful candidate for the program. I have compiled a packet of information about the program and sent the information to the inmate via institutional mail. If interested the inmate is directed to complete the documentation in the packet and take the completed documents to their assigned Correctional Counselor I for review and committee evaluation.
