



**Families affected by  
having a parent in jail and/or prison

**WHY ARE WE DOING THIS STUDY?**

We are conducting this study to identify needs, supports, and barriers to supports for families affected by incarceration.

**WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?**

Parents who have been released from jail or prison within 1 year, AND caregivers of children with incarcerated parents in jail or prison (past or current).

**WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IN THE STUDY?**

- You will participate in a 30-90 minute phone call.
- You will be asked about your experiences with household incarceration
- You will be asked about specific needs and barriers to supports

**WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATING?**

- Participation is voluntary.
- The research study is confidential.
- You will receive a \$40 gift card for your time.
- Information from this interview will help inform interventions to support families impacted by incarceration.
