

Families affected by having a parent in jail and/or prison are needed for a research study

WHY ARE WE DOING THIS STUDY?

We are conducting this study to identify needs, supports, and barriers to supports for families affected by incarceration.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Parents who have been released from jail or prison within 1 year, AND caregivers of children with incarcerated parents in jail or prison (past or current).

WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IN THE STUDY?

- You will participate in a 30-90 minute phone call.
- You will be asked about your experiences with household incarceration
- · You will be asked about specific needs and barriers to supports

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATING?

- Participation is voluntary.
- The research study is confidential.
- You will receive a \$40 gift card for your time.
- Information from this interview will help inform interventions to support families impacted by incarceration.
