They claimed, based on my disciplinary record in prison, that i "lack insight" into my criminal behavior and that i pose "an unreasonable risk to public safety". This is because i denied the veracity and accuracy of falsified Rule Violation Reports (RVRs), and justified my use of violence as "defensive force" against aggressors.

i will continue to comply with recommended self-help/rehabilitative programs and pursue my educational goals/job-training in spite of this adverse and biased parole board finding.
