SUBJECT:

FCC Petersburg Return to Phase One Modified Operations

As a result in the increase of COVID-19 cases throughout the Complex, among staff and inmates, and throughout the United States, as well as in the State of Virginia, effective immediately, FCC Petersburg is implementing a "Stay in Shelter until further notice to curb the spread of COVID-19 within the complex. This is not punitive but rather a complex-wide effort and response to a public health emergency. This action is designed as a response to the evolving nature of COVID-19, while maintaining the safety and security of our facilities and the health of all employees and inmates. Additionally, all inmates experiencing any recent COVID-19-like symptoms such as cough, fever, sore throat, headaches, body aches, nasal/chest congestion, and/or runny nose should contact Health Services using the appropriate sick call slip.

Please ensure no more than **ONE** inmate orderly is out at a time. They should not be assisting with any meal distribution. When feeding is completed, only **ONE** orderly can come out and wipe down the highly touched areas. They can complete their normal cleaning; then go back to their cell. They should **NOT** be out all day. They are to finish their cleaning duties and then they should be secured. They need to be directly supervised at all times and should **NOT** be permitted to go from cell to cell. This goes for weekdays and weekends. Orderlies are **NOT** to be out after 4 p.m. count unless authorized by the Captains. Orderlies and inmates that are provided showers are not allowed to charge MP-3 players or re-validate for themselves or other inmates.

We appreciate your cooperation and flexibility as we do everything we can to assure the safety and security of our staff, inmates, and the general public. This is the most responsible action to take at this time in an attempt to curb the spread of COVID-19.

I'm sitting in bed once again as "D Begin to Wonder (Dead or A live Remix)" by Dannie Minoque plays on C3PD. A lot has happened in the few days since I sent off my last posting. I left If with the full, lockdown which started this past Sunday. Yesterday, after only three days, they let us back out. We are now back on the previous schedule we were on before they let us go outside again. This is the schedule where they bring our meals to us + lock us down around 2: 45p. They are also having a 10 s "count" again - which they started doing again when the lockdown started. I am so glad the full lockdown ended quickly. They didn't give us showers at all while we were locked down + since my previous showers were interrupted, I hadn't had a complete shower since Friday. It is so nice to feel clean again.

In more drama ... early yesterday, before they even let us out in the morning shortly after 7A, all the kitchen workers were sent back to their unit (D-North, above us). I believe they sent back all the workers there Laundry & Commissary, etc. There were two rumors: one was that they were all being shaken down cause it was reported that a lot of COs went up the there; the rumor which I believe is correct is that someone in that unit was exposed to COVID & the entire unit is on lockdown. I am pretty certain they are on full lockdown cause they also moved a bunch of kitchen workers, from other units who hadn't previously been called back to work into this unit. They moved three black guys out of the four-man cell two doors down from us (and across from the showers there a mentioned last time) and moved in three white 50s (sex offenders) and a Hispanic, That should clean up the neighborhood a bit - and quiet things down greatly Oh, they've continued to let us out in the mornings this week instead of the afternoon, My cellie, Sick, said that he heard that every other unit had the top tier out in the morning that week + that we were the only unit that was different. Who knows?

One of the guys who was moved to this unit is Cohnny, with whom I lived in B- South right after I got to this prison. He also happens to be the person who was saying that XP died from an OD, as a mentioned last time. He also "laims" that he is allergic to red fruit only. I highly doubt that's true. Fri, 01/01/21 5:15p Happy Lew Year! What an awful year 2020 was! So for (well, it's only been one day), 2021 is not starting out well. For the record, "Casus Was A B-Boy (TI Kong & Nuno Dos Santos Remix)" by Ben Mono is playing on (3PO. It's a really funny song. It's been a while since I last wrote. I just haven't been "feeling it." I managed to stay out of the Hole this Christmas, thankfully, but unfortunately we are back on a full lockdown again as of two days ago. So, I spent my New Year's locked in a cell again, This past Wed. started normally enough. We were out in the morning this time after finally getting out in the afternoon last week. Although being out in the morning really suchs - by the time we get out for breshfast we only have about an hour before it's my "shower time" and then

we re locked down for count - this time it was really fortunate. After the count clears, we get maybe a half hour before lunch shows up & we re locked to down again. This time we were out for 10-15 minutes + the (O yelled "lockdown." We were lucky to get some time out (plus a slower) and the lower tier got screwed. The whole compound is now on a full lockdown. If I remember, I'll include the latest memo from the Warden. A wording to one of the orderlies, there are 20 COs out with COVID. I don't know if that's over the whole complet (with the "Low and the "Comp") or just us. Again, his memo says that this isn't "punitive," however, they had some staff members come in and take out the charging station for our MP3s and he lowered the commissary spending limit from \$50 to \$ 25. How is that not sunishment? We can't charge or revalidate own MP3 , and can only spend a measly \$ 25 at commissary (not that I have even that - I'm shopping for someone else (which I should explain later). This Warden is a COAPLETE ASSHOLE. We are being punished because the COs are bringing COVID into this institution. NTF? Please feel free to contact your Congressman to complain about how we're being punished like this.

the "shopping for someone else" thing. Due to the ridiculous spending limits at commissary (or, when someone just wants to spend more), some guys will find others who are poor (like me) & have their family / friends put money on that person's account so the second inmate can buy commissary for the first inmate, The second inmate then gets to keep a portion of that money (normally 10%, although when the limit was 550 it was 20% (\$10)) to spend for themselves. This has worked out great for me as that has enabled me to buy hygiene or coffee instead of going So, during this lockdown, since I have only rarely been able to go to the Library to type, I have supported myself by writing out legal stuff (letters, BOP complaints or Compassionate Release requests mainly), by selling my commissary account, or by doing massages (at \$3 for a half howr - no "happy endings!"), or doing those betting tickets - and this is the last week of the regular season so that ends soon, down it, (for the record, a don't bet and don't even know how all that works). Back to the full lockdown news ... this is when

we're let out only three times a week to shower & that's it. Because today was a holiday, they let us out yesterday to shower. This means we won't get another shower until blanday at the earliest, This shit really sucks, Once again we have no idea how long this will last, but I am fairly certain it will be a bit longer than that last very slout lockdown. Thurs, 01-07-21 5:51p Here I am in bed again (still) as "With Every Beat Of My Heart (Extended Radio Ramix)" by Taylor Dayne plays on C3PO. I only have five more days that I can play my MP3 before it stops playing since I can't revalidate it on the computer. Fucking bullshit. I haven't been using it much so I still have 80% of battery life left. Fortunately, Sich bought one of their cleap-ass windup radios so we can watch to. He lets me use it when there is nothing he wants to watch. Those radios are garbage & they have lots of problems. They're a model Sangean HAR-77 and they charge us about \$62 for them. They re a total rip-off.

The past Christmas and New Year's meals were the worst D've ever had + so were our Christmas bags that we get (filled with snacks). This was a bad holiday season. There was some drama which happened a week or two before the lockdown, We got a new trans Casmine, who came from Marion (where I'm considering asking to transfer to). Carmine is Hispanic and is a "homegirl" of mine since she's from El Paso. She's also really nice. A nizway, as I previously mentioned, there are only two "white" tables in this unit, and Casmine used to mainly sit at one of them as the people there were her main friends. I'dle, some asshole who was recently moved here from F. South decided he didn't want Casmine sitting at that table. I don't know of it's 'cause she's a transing or cause she's Hispanic. sat there with her + told her that she could sit wherever she wanted. Plus, this guy is new + he doesn't run shit around here (so to speak), He ended up calling us both up to his cell + said that if she ever sat there again, he would push her.

off the stool. What a Jucking asshole. Almost all of Casmine's supposed "friends" "bitchedout" and said nothing to this year, Dave, and still act cool with him. So take. Q, of course, am not one of those people. He tried to talk to me again + I told him to leave. Unless he apologizes to Cusmine & tells her it's OK to sit there, he can go fuck himself as far as I'm The only people (that I know of) who stuck up for Casmine are my cellie, Vick, who offered to talk to Dave + tell him off-which Casmine declined - and Steph, a transy from the bottom tier who did tell Dave that Casmine wild sit there if she wanted to. (Steph was out of her cell 'cause her cellie is a worker, so her edl was unlocked). When both tiers are out, Dave won't sit there anyway cause guys from the bottom tier always set at that table as it is "their" spot , which I learned when I was moved to this unit. So screw him! Casmine still won't sit there cause she's avoiding problems. #GONELONGENOUGH
