We've been partially locked down a long time. We just got off an intensified lockdown following lots of covid infections in the prison. Two of my friends on the unit died of it. One was a very good artist, and a talented self taught electronics repairman. The other was a druggie that I enjoyed arguing with from time to time.

The only art supplies available have been colored pencils. The pencil sharpener is necessary because the pigment core of those pencils fracture easily if you use a toenail clipper to whittle them. Anyway I submit an original, "The Ship Chandler".
