I specifically want to speak to the young people on the streets and the rappers. There has to be unity. We got to have each other back. We often put everything on the opposite ~~race~~ race. But the truth of the matter racism does exist. However this inner racism has to stop Black on Black crimes. It's enough room in the game for everyone. I could say hey you need to leave the street life along. But the truth of matter for some people

That is not going to happen. So I am going this way. We got to move better in these streets. I am going to share little of instance. Just the other day. I had an encounter with this girl. I thought we was cool so her hair was ~~to~~ hanging on her neck neck. so I took it in brush it up with the other ~~hair~~ hair. She said don't touch me. Then she said you have never done me like that before. ~~But~~ I said I didn't mean no harm. She said aint none of such ~~and so~~ so, so without calling name. I told this girl before I knowed, ya I aint scared of you. What's up. my street instincts had amped up. I had to go somewhere in cool down because people will try you. I had another instant where ~~the girl~~ these girls keep talking noise today. Throwing salt up in the air at me. my street instinct wanted to kick ~~up~~ say, like yo what's up. you get smoke with me. Give me my one. Being reared in Jersey, you had to be on your guards at all time because someone going to try you up.

~~From one street to another.~~ From one ~~street~~ person to another ^{street} person. We got to choose our battle better. I would fight at the drop of a dime. So when someone piss you off or threaten you. Do you really have to smoke them with your weapon. Why not say ok. when we all cool down lets try to hash this out. If that don't work. you don't say nothing to them they don't say anything to you. But I know it don't always work like ~~that~~ that because some people going to ~~be~~ beef it up everytime they see you and they going to get you. I've encountered that type of person. I had to end up fighting her. But I end up moving to Georgia. I do feel when I finally go home to New Jersey. I am going to have to watch my back. Because this same girl end up ~~on~~ on my sister facebook account after all these years. So I understand what a lot of you all going through out there in these streets. Street life is not easy for no one. People get jealous of your success. They literally want to take you out of the spot light. If they don't shine you want either. You're not all that bro. The streets has all types of people in it. Sometimes the layers are deep. Dealing with another bro or sis on the streets. But you all got to move better gun some down is not always the solution on fighting. I often fell people thinks before you react.

Prison life is not the answer. either. I have done 25 years off a life with possibility parole in Georgia. you kill someone you are ~~going~~ coming to this ^{joint} ~~joint~~. Prison is not safe any more. Prison life is just like street life now. you can get killed up in here there are not that many guards. I pray all the time please protect me. If you dont have nobody to send you money. you hungry all the time. Gt to be cautious of the next inmate. you dont know what they want in return. If your not gay like them they pick fights with you trying to make you fight them. Being in ~~lock~~ lock down in prison is awful. The one in segregation store sheet is so small. yard calls what yard calls. We just barely have a guard. The food is not all that. something are ok like the hamburgers, hot dogs and chicken. you eat the same thing 365 days a year. If your in those streets and living a street life. Its going to end ~~up~~ by death or prison. I encourage every youth, thug if that what you call yourself. I use call myself a girl thug. Its never too late to change course in life. I've change course to education so when I do get out. I will have a good job to support myself. I wouldn't look for a fast fix you know what I mean. I encourage every one under the sound of my voice there is hope for you. There is a brighter pathway you can get on Malcom, Atlanta, Chicago, etc. Gun somebody down is not their answer bro. Think about your life.
