RE: 103 CMR 483 – Visiting Procedures

The Department of Correction is instituting the following changes to the Visiting Procedures effective March 1st, 2019:

1. The maximum number of PRE-APPROVED visitors for Maximum Security level will be increased to eight (8) visitors.

NOTE: If an inmate's immediate family exceeds the maximum number allowed and the inmate only has immediate family listed on his/her visitor list, then exceptions may be made to exceed this number, upon request from the inmate and with the written approval of the Superintendent.

2. An inmate's visitor list may be revised every 120 days utilizing the Inmate Visitor Listing Form (Attachment 3 to 103 CMR 483). During the months of March, July and November, inmates may submit their requests for changes within the first 15 days of the month to the Director of Security for processing in accordance with facility procedure.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the inmate to notify and inform his/her visitor(s) to submit a Visitor Application.

In accordance with the 103 CMR 483: Department of Corrections Visiting Policy;. Additions/Deletions will be three times yearly, every 120 days.

At this time, we are not accepting any Inmate Visitor Listing, Attachment 3 until the next change period, which is July 1, 2021 through July 15, 2021 then again November 1, 2021 through November 15, 2021 and again March 1, 2022 through March 15, 2022.

Medium security level inmates are allowed eight (8) pre-approved visitors and two (2) video visit per week, one (1) visit per day.
