INTRODUCTION

HOW TO OPEN A GROUP

"If Scientology is ever to travel, it will be accomplished by groups."

(LRH, HCO Policy Letter 5 July 1957, LONESOME?)

Creating a new civilization here on Earth will only be done by Scientologists in the field who decide to take more responsibility for changing conditions around them. This will be done by *you* working together with fellow Scientologists or members of your community who are also interested in making a better world for all to live in.

One day Earth will be defined as "that planet where people settle things peacefully via Scientology groups." It is vital that every Scientologist play a role in expanding Scientology and making this happen. It will only be done with you deciding to make the difference, and becoming part of a team that will bring this about.

Today Scientology continues to expand on all fronts through the contributions and efforts of thousands upon thousands of Scientologists around the world. This expansion is brought about by Scientologists from all walks of life working together in groups, as a team, to get LRH's technology into use and improving conditions in the world.

Field Scientologists around the world are establishing field auditor groups, OT Committees, Auditors Associations, Dianetics Counseling Groups and study groups, and are working together in a shoulder-to-shoulder effort to clear this planet. Armed with a strong purpose and LRH's tech and policy to guide them, these groups are making major strides in improving their communities.

There are groups and committees that have been established to help increase dissemination and delivery in their areas, to get LRH books into the hands of the public and help people to get on to the Bridge to Total

Freedom. Other Scientologists are expanding the scope of Dianetics and Scientology delivery across the globe by opening new groups and in some cases introducing whole countries to Dianetics and Scientology for the first time ever.

You can open a group just with what you know right now! It can involve as little or as much time as you currently have to offer. Perhaps you will make it into a one-night-a-week or weekend activity, or you may decide that you want to build a career for yourself from one of the group activities covered in this manual.

Many of the activities that Scientologists around the world can do today are covered in this manual. The purpose of this manual is to provide you with the information you need to open your own group or join in one, and to show you just how easy it is to do so.

WHAT IS A GROUP

A group is a team activity composed of Scientologists in the field, friends who are interested in being involved, as well as people in the community who operate on a common purpose and stay in good communication with each other while getting projects done to improve conditions around them. No matter what your interest or ability, you can connect up with others of similar interests who can help you become more effective in expanding and disseminating Scientology.

There can be no group at all without each group member participating and contributing. This is what makes a true team with each member a true group member.

Successful groups are connected up tightly to their local org and work with them, as a team, to create big effects in the area. The Groups I/C or Public Programs Officer is the person in your local org who will help you with guidance as well as projects to get you started achieving your group's objectives.

Being connected to the org and having a person there to share the results and wins of your group with makes having a group even more rewarding. By reporting your activities to the org's Field Control Division regularly, they can be made known and your successes can be broadly promoted.

THE FIRST STEPS

The first step to opening a group is to make the decision that you can do something about clearing the planet and know that you will create greater effects by joining up with others who have similar purposes. The power created by a group will allow you to rapidly achieve your objectives.

Work out what type of group you want to open and know that you already have the know-how you need to do this. Contact the Groups I/C or Public Programs Officer in your nearest org and he will give you the assistance and support you need to get started. He can help by providing you with names of other Scientologists in your area to contact as members for your group or by giving you projects for your group to begin with.

Then you just need to use the data contained in this manual and get going. It's as simple as that.

TYPES OF GROUPS

There are a variety of groups for Scientologists to open or join. By knowing what these groups are and what they are meant to accomplish, you can choose the type of group best suited to align with your own purposes. In doing so, your success in opening a group will be ensured.

FIELD AUDITOR GROUP

Field auditor groups have been around since the first field auditor himself, LRH, began working with other individuals to deliver his technology. They formed the core of our Scientology organizations today and continue to play a vital part in Scientology expansion.

Field groups bring order into a chaotic society. They offer safe islands of sanity where people can find the answers that will bring order into their lives.

Field groups have a wide array of services to deliver including everything from Book One auditing to the highest level of Grade Chart auditing that the auditor is trained on. With a trained Supervisor as part of the group, basic Dianetics and Scientology courses can also be delivered.

By specializing in a specific area of the tech, the members of a field group can become experts in what they do while becoming known and respected in their area.

Imagine getting trained up as Purification Rundown In-Charge and Case Supervisor and then opening up a Purification Center that introduces new public to this technology. With *Clear Body, Clear Mind* on sale in bookstores around the world, the reach for this tech is greater than ever. By running a Purification Center field group, you can help fulfill this need in society.

An auditor trained as a Marriage Counselor can set up his own Marriage Consultant field group and popularize this tech as the obvious

solution to marital problems in his area. Or a group of trained Supervisors can provide the answers to the basic ruins in life by delivering Life Improvement Courses at their Scientology Life Improvement Center.

Who knows, once your field group takes off, you may even want to set up a chain of these groups that spans your entire community and its surrounding areas.

DIANETICS COUNSELING GROUPS

Opening a Dianetics Counseling Group is vital to scooping up the millions of Dianetics bookbuyers out in the world who have yet to find where to go to get the tech applied to them.

The very first Dianetics groups actually began shortly after the release of DMSMH in 1950. Thriving groups that delivered Book One auditing sprang up all around the world using LRH's new technology and this resulted in a Book One boom. Dianetics Counseling Groups were the forerunners to many of the organizations that we now have today.

With the multitudes of people who have bought *Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health* but have yet to be contacted and started on to service, it is easy to see that opening a Dianetics Counseling Group would be invaluable for expanding Dianetics in your area. Picture a team of Hubbard New Era Dianetics Auditors from your Dianetics Counseling Group on the scene at every sports event, called in for emergency assists, creating miracles that get immediately broadcast to the community.

The Groups In-Charge in the Department of Clearing of your local org is responsible for ensuring that Book One Auditors in the field get help in establishing their own Dianetics Counseling Groups. The org will provide you with the needed materials, hatting and guidance necessary to successfully set up a group in the field that delivers Dianetics.

By disseminating through raw public book sales; delivering lectures as well as the Hubbard Dianetics Seminar and Hubbard Dianetics Auditor Course; delivering New Era Dianetics auditing, Book One auditing and additional auditing services; and running Dianetics Book Extension Courses, a Dianetics Counseling Group can flourish and prosper while helping the community.

GUNG-HO GROUPS

In Mandarin Chinese, *gung-ho* means "pull together." The Gung-ho Group is a type of group set up by LRH which gets members actively applying Scientology towards the creation of a new civilization.

Gung-ho Groups reach out into their communities, and using LRH's tech, bring about immediate improvements in the society. The Gung-ho Group pulls together other groups in the community. They find out what the people in that area want to get handled, work out solutions to handle these problems, work with other local groups and actually do handle these problems. They strive towards the betterment of society and of the area.

Gung-ho Groups are meant to be out there in the community, communicating with the public and providing what is wanted. Key to the success of any Gung-ho Group is doing something about the targets that the area is interested in achieving. This might be getting drugs out of schools or handling drunk drivers, possibly cleaning up the local parks or building a community center. Whatever the needs and wants of the people are, you can then direct your projects and programs on to what will be most accepted by the public at large in order to improve your community.

A Gung-ho Group finds out through surveys what the individual *citizens* in the community most want to improve in the area. Then by proposing a project to local groups and with your Gung-ho Group working along with other civic groups in your area, you coordinate your actions so that all are headed in the same direction.

A functioning Gung-ho Group, working on revitalizing society, will soon see the benefits being created in the community.

The Public Programs Officer of your local org will assist you in getting your Gung-ho Group started. He can provide you with ideas and projects that forward the aims of Scientology while enhancing your community.

AUDITORS ASSOCIATION

LRH set up the first Auditors Association at the end of the 1960s following the banishment of quickie grades which had left auditors with little to audit. He did this to ensure that auditors in all areas of the world were briefed on current events and changes.

An Auditors Association is made up of trained auditors in an area who are interested in achieving the overall purpose: "TO GET DIANETICS AND SCIENTOLOGY INTO POWER IN THE COMMUNITY." By forming up an Auditors Association and working with other auditors towards achieving this purpose, one can get Dianetics and Scientology into Power.

LRH ED 120 Int, AUDITORS ASSOCIATION PROJECT IN YOUR AREA, lays out simple steps showing what to do to form up an Auditors

Association in any area. The Auditors Association gets auditors united, makes sure they keep abreast of technical releases and their tech is kept standard. Auditors assist each other in their activities and can even organize co-audits.

There is no limit to the create an Auditors Association can put into their activities. Through various projects and programs done by the group members, you succeed in making auditors opinion leaders in your area.

The Auditors Association works with the org to get more public moving towards becoming trained auditors or by helping to recover those auditors who are no longer auditing. The world needs auditors. An Auditors Association can help in seeing that the world is provided with them.

Imagine being active in your Auditors Association, winning by getting projects done, increasing the pool of auditor resources in your area and then getting them active in spreading the news about Dianetics and Scientology.

Through the above actions and establishing an effective Auditors Association, you can be part of building up a strong body of trained auditors who become an effective power in your community.

OT COMMITTEE

The concept for the first OT Committee was established in the mid-60s when an OT Central Committee was set up to utilize OTs for this purpose: "TO HELP LRH ORGANIZE AND CHANNEL OT FORCES, INTERESTS AND RESOURCES FOR THE GREATEST GOOD FOR SCIENTOLOGY."

It was established at this time that other OT Committees would be set up in the field. Today an OT Committee belongs on the Division 6C org board under the Department of Success. The Public Programs Officer is the staff member in an org responsible for ensuring that there is an active and functioning OT Committee working on projects that accomplish the same above purpose.

An OT Committee organizes all the Clears and OTs in an area, and gets them working together on valuable projects that forward the expansion of Scientology.

The projects of an OT Committee include activities that will make LRH, Dianetics and/or Scientology well known and well thought of in the community. Your OT Committee could get such things as "Scientology:

Improving Life in a Troubled World" cassette readings from the Scientology books of LRH being played on local radio stations. You could be actively getting LRH books, tapes and videos placed in local libraries so that they are available for the community at large. There is no limit to the create you can have on this.

Through "EFFECTIVE CAUSE WELL DEMONSTRATED" in your projects and activities, your OT Committee will be promoting Scientology and creating further interest that will result in the greatest good for Scientology and your org.

STUDY GROUP

A study group is made up of several individuals who are looking for answers to improve conditions in their lives. By using basic LRH books, key data can be studied that will provide further insight and understanding into the problems of life. Then the group works out how to use these basic data to address the problem areas which results in increased survival for all involved.

Study groups have been around since the early 1950s when LRH first released *Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health*. Wanting to know more about this new technology and what it had to say about the mind, individuals were prompted to get together with people they knew in order to expand on their understanding of Dianetics. Hence, the study group.

Many of the early Dianetics and Scientology activities took off from there. And people's lives were changed as a result.

SUMMARY

Scientology groups form the beachheads in society from which Scientology will travel to all corners of the globe. Groups actively applying the tech of Dianetics and Scientology in the field in order to achieve their purposes will help Scientology to expand and make the world a better place to live.

With every field Scientologist actively working in and with groups on a regular basis to improve conditions and spread the news of Dianetics and Scientology, we will be unstoppable.

HOW TO OPEN A STUDY GROUP

A Study Group is a field activity where a group meets and defines and then utilizes basic Dianetics and Scientology data contained in LRH books and materials in order to resolve the problems of life.

Starting one is simply a matter of getting a group of people together (such as friends, neighbors or family members) who have an interest in improving an area of their lives. The members of the group can then meet regularly in one of the group member's home or some other easily accessible location.



A Study Group is comprised of a number of friends and Scientologists who have a mutual interest in improving their lives. These groups should not include more than 20 people. Where the group grows unwieldy, there is less time for consideration of the individual problems of those who compose the group.




The first step at a Study Group meeting is to use the material in an LRH book as a basis for discussion. Appoint one Scientologist as the leader of the group who will supervise this discussion.



The leader goes over Dianetics and Scientology definitions and data in basic LRH books with the other members of the Study Group.



Now he wouldn't just read these to them, he would study them with them until they understood what was meant by it or what they thought was meant by it and that is where it makes its gain. They evaluate what is meant by this according to their own background and experience.



A portion of every Study Group program from the first one on is a presentation by each member of some of the specific personal problems they are having with the topic being discussed. The group then discusses each problem in an attempt to help the member resolve this with Dianetics or Scientology technology.



The group then tests these solutions in the personal life of every group member whose problem is similar.



At subsequent meetings is a discussion of the practical applications of the solutions suggested, and an evaluation of the results with a view to striving for constant improvement.

One obtains long-range targets by ringing doorbells and going into shops and asking individuals what they think should be done on community projects.




When this is done the Gung-ho Group plans out what objectives to achieve based on these surveys.




TARGET BOARDS

There are TWO different target boards.

One board is for the Gung-ho Group; this gives the targets for current long-range actions of the group itself.



The other board is the Community Target Board. On this is posted the long-range targets of the community and the short-range targets of the various civic groups.



Most groups run by membership fees or contributions and are rarely prosperous enough to maintain themselves.

The group activities are financed by the following:

A percentage of FSM commissions.



Membership fees.



Any contributions.



Course fees for courses it teaches.
