I, William Irving # 182906, being  
first duly sworn upon my oath, depose and state:

1) I attest that in the last (18) eighteen months  
(1½ years) since about around August of 2022  
or better, specifically in Administrative Segregat-  
ion ("Ad-Seg") Housing Unit #7 ("H.U.#7") I and other  
prisoners similarly situated have been subjected to  
the following unconstitutional confinement in violat-  
ion of our (8th) Eighth Amendment right to the U.S.  
Constitution and (14th) Fourteenth Amendment right  
by these Supervisors and their Subordinates Under  
their control and direction Superintendent Ms. Doris  
Falkenrath #E0116678; Assistant Warden Raina Martin #  
E00120257; COV. Major Norman Graham; COIV. Captain  
Debra Reed; Functional Unit Manager Mark Leonard #E0-  
100392; COT. Jeffery Tallent #E0418561; COT. Sgt.  
Lenny; and COT. Sgt. J. Sanni #E0140418

2) Unsafe Conditions. Emergency Call Buttons are  
not being answered by all three (3) shifts in H.U.#7  
as a result (3) three prisoners have been found dead  
(1) one in cell 7-a-104 around October of 2021 (note:  
he tried to self-declare an medical emergency  
at 8:00pm medication pass, nurse (Kurd) and

guard told him to f-ck-off!). At least (7-11) seven-to-eleven (or more) prisoners have been stabbed (i.e. Kyrie Hughes; etc.) for guard deliberately putting/pulling prisoners not assigned to their cell(s) into their cell(s). And guards disaffording prisoners (majority of timed to self-declare medical emergencies.

3) Sick calls have only been done (3 or 4) three or four times instead of (5) five days per week.

4) Unsanitary Conditions. Showers and wings have went multiple months "filthy" and highly health-hazardous littered with trash; blood; human feces upon soiled paper mentally disturbed prisoners push in the wing (several times piles of sh-t have been found in showers) and wings often wreak of urine and human feces. Guards repeatedly have stopped prisoner walkmen workers from adequately cleaning.

5) Haircuts (are supposed to be done once per month) have only been done twice in ten (10) months. Prisoners have developed sores on their scalps are eating hair in their food unable to get a haircut or shave.

6) Denial of weekly reading books. Reading books

have not been and or not being passed out each week to all prisoners, nor are guards/supervisors going to get books from library every (2) two weeks.

7) Deprival of clean clothing/bedding. Guards refused to do laundry until recently.

8) It should be noted that all guards and supervisors assigned to H.U.#7 deliberately curbed their job duties by going in caseworkers' offices to sleep; watch football games; eat snacks, and sexually harass women employees which breached our Constitutional Rights.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746 I declare upon the penalty of perjury that the facts stated herein are true and correct.
