Is War Worth it?

Open our spiritual eyes! I want to share something from the book "Angel Armies Releasing the Warriors of Heaven" by Tim Sheets. ~~Something~~ A massive shaking of spirit realms over regions is promised in the last days. Hebrews 12:26 tells us that the Lord will shake not only the earth, but also the heavens. We certainly are seeing great shaking on the earth today. Creation is indeed groaning with natural disasters occurring everywhere. Hurricanes, tsunamis, drought, and famines are killing millions of people. Wars, rumors of wars, earthquakes increasing in number and intensity, financial calamities abounding, and great economies are going bankrupt. What Jesus said would occur at the end of the age is being seen in our newspaper headlines (p. 114)

You will hear of wars and rumors of wars, see that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. All these are the beginning of sorrows (Matthew 24:6-8 NKJV). whose voice then shook the earth; but now He has promised, saying, "yet once more I shake not only the earth, but also heaven." Now this, "yet once more," indicates the removal of these things which cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire (Hebrew 12:26-29 NKJV).

The Shaking of the earth has been much talked about

in recent times. Yes thankfully if you have ~~received~~ received Christ as your Lord and Savior according to Romans 10:9-13 we are part of a kingdom that cannot be shaken. But He also says that He will shake the heavens (Sheets, 2016, p. 116-117) He is not talking about His Heaven (the heaven where God lives) that Paul called the third heaven - it doesn't need to be shaken. It's perfect. The heaven mentioned here is referring to spiritual realms also known as heavenly places in the New ~~Testament~~ Testament. The apostle Paul in the book of Ephesians emphasizes this. Ephesians 1:3 says, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ" (NIV). The Amplified Bible says in that verse, "every spiritual (given by the Holy Spirit) blessing in the heavenly realm. This includes power and authority in heavenly places, because power from on high has been poured out upon the people of God, upon the church."

Ephesians 2:6 describes what Christ has done for us this way, "And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus." A seat of governing power is involved. The Amplified Bible reads, "And He raised us up together with Him and made us sit down together [giving us joint seating with Him] in the heavenly sphere [by virtue of our being] in Christ Jesus (the Messiah, the Anointed one)." In the heavenly spheres, the church, the ekklesia, is to sit down together with Christ on the throne of that region and rule and reign with him, releasing the power of the Holy Spirit and losing angel armies to assist in clearing out the demon strongholds that are over Israel, Ukraine. Ephesians 3:10, "To the intent that now unto the principalities and power in heavenly places might

be known by the church the manifested wisdom of God.
The church is to decree the laws, judgments, plans, purposes, and principles of God's Word to principalities and powers in the heavenly places. The church, not hell's ~~the~~ kingdom, is to define the message and culture of a region. King Jesus commanded that. And if demons get in the way, He says to cast them down and ask for angel armies. The ekklesia is to occupy the throne of their region and give an uncompromised Gospel, insisting that the will of God be done in that region and battle with hell to see that it stays that way. If the church will rise up and rule in His name, angel armies will fight alongside of them against hell's power (p. 118)

We have to stay repenting according to 1 John 1:9. So you hear all kinds of message like the bible is ~~ful~~ fulfilling itself. But where is the church focus? I was think about the word Distraction. Everytime something good is going to happen, the devil send something ~~to~~ to distract us. The bible says in John 10:10 the enemy comes to steal, kill and destroy. Once again Israel, Ukraine and America where is your focus? I understand things are bad in Israel ~~and~~ Ukraine, and America. But why focus on the ~~problems~~ problems? I am reminded of Jehoshaphat, when a vast of army came up against. 1 Chronicles ~~20~~ 20:3-6 when the nation was faced with disaster, Jehoshaphat called upon the people to get serious with God by going without food (fasting) for a designated time. By separating themselves from daily routine of food preparation and eating, they could devote that extra time to considering their sin and praying to ~~for~~ God for help. Hunger pangs would reinforce their feelings of penitence and remind them of their weakness and their dependence upon God. Fasting still can be helpful today as we seek God's will in a special situations. P.S. Jehoshaphat recovered everything the enemy stole from them.

Prayer is powerful - I try to send this message everywhere I go ~~and to the people I come~~ Chronicles 20:6 Jehoshaphat's prayer had several essential ingredients. (1) He committed the situation to God, acknowledging that only God could save the nation. (2) he sought God's favor because his people were God's people. (3) He acknowledge God's sovereignty over the current situation. (4) He praised God's glory and took comfort in his promises. (5) He professed complete dependence on God, not himself,

for deliverance. To God's kind of leader today, follow Jehoshaphat's example - focus entirely on God's power rather than your own strength.

Music is powerful: 1 Chronicles 20:20. Early in the morning they left for the Desert of Tekoa. As they set out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Listen to me, Judah and people of Jerusalem! Have faith in the Lord your God and you will be upheld; have faith in his prophets and you will be successful." After consulting the people, Jehoshaphat appointed men to sing to the Lord and to praise him for the ~~splendor~~ splendor of his holiness as they went out at the head of army saying; Give thanks to the Lord for his love endures forever. As they began to praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab Seir who were invading Judah, and they were defeated. The men of Ammon and Moab rose up against the men from Mount Seir to destroy and ~~and~~ annihilate them.

I would play the song "War" by Charles Jenkins: If I was Ukrainian or Israeli because it's the best spiritual warfare song that has been ever written by a gospel artist. This song has so much power that it will confuse the devil or cause a person to want to be saved. We all have problems that we need answers to; however, remember this is not a flesh battle for real so you must get to the enemy. Ephesians 6:10 says finally; be strong in the Lord and his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world

and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. In Christian life we battle against rulers and authorities (the powerful evil forces of fallen angels headed by Satan, who is a vicious fighter see 1 Peter 5:8) Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers and sisters throughout the world are ~~going~~ undergoing the same kind of sufferings. To withstand the attacks, we must depend on God's strength and use every piece of his armor, Paul is not only giving this counsel to the church, the body of Christ, but to all individuals within the church. The whole body needs to be armed. As you do battle against "the powers of this dark world, fight in the strength of the church, whose power comes from the holy spirit. These are not "flesh and blood" are demons over whom Satan has control.

They are not mere fantasies - they are very real. We face a powerful army whose goal is to defeat Christ's Church. When we believe in Christ, these beings become our enemies, and they try every device to turn us away from him and back to sin. Although we are assured of victory, we must engage in the struggle until Christ returns, because Satan is constantly battling against all who are on the Lord's side. We need supernatural power to defeat Satan, and God has provided this by giving us his holy spirit within us and his armor surrounding us. If you feel discouraged Israel | Ukraine remember Jesus words to Peter, "On this rock I will build my church and the gates of Hades will not overcome it" (Matthew 16:18).

As we reflect back to Jehoshaphat. As the enemy

bore down on Judah, God spoke through Jahaziel:
Do not be afraid or discourage Israel... for the
battle is not yours, but God's. We may not fight
an enemy army, everyday we battle temptations,
pressure, and rulers... of this dark world Ephraim
6:12 who wants to rebel against God. Remember,
as believers, we have God's spirit in us. If we ask
for God's help when we face struggles. God will fight
for us, and God always triumphs. How do we let
God fight for us? (1) By realizing the battle is not ours,
but God's; (2) by recognizing human limitations and
allowing God's strength to work through our fears
and weaknesses; (3) by making sure we are pursuing
God's interests and not just our own selfish desires;
(4) by asking God for help in our daily battles.

distinct characteristics; (1) It is practical. The

trying times. It is not a wisdom isolated from suffering and trials. This wisdom is the tool by which trials are overcome. An intelligent person may have profound ideas, but a wise person puts profound ideas into action. Intelligence will allow someone to describe several reasons why the car broke down. The wise person chooses the most likely reason and proceeds to take action. (2) It is divine. God's wisdom goes beyond common sense. Common sense does not lead us to choose joy in the middle of trials. This wisdom begins with respect for God, leads to living by God's direction, and results in the ability to tell right from wrong. ~~This is wisdom that James will describe at length~~ (3) It is Christlike. Asking for wisdom is ultimately asking to be Christlike. The Bible identifies Christ as the "wisdom of God" (1 Corinthians 1:24; 2:1-7). An important nugget: James 1:19, 20. These verses speak of anger that erupts when our ego's are bruised - "I am hurt"; my opinions are not being heard." When injustice and sin occur, we should not become angry when we fail to win an argument or when we feel offended or neglected. Selfish anger never helps anybody. Some things ~~are~~ are meant to pray about. Ephesians 6:18. How can anyone pray on all occasions? One way is make quick, brief, brief prayers your habitual response to every situation you meet throughout the day. Another way is to order your life around God's desire and teachings so that your very life become a prayer. You don't have to isolate yourself from other people and from daily work in order to pray constantly. You can make prayer your life and your life a prayer while living in a world that needs God's powerful influence. "Praying for all the saints" means praying for all believers in Christ; so pray for the Christians you

Know and for the church around the world.
