It has been my experience, and should be your firm's concern, M/H is obsequious to custody's demands even knowing a forced move at advanced age and declining health could be and has been lethal. At my CHCF Transfer hearing Sept 22, the attending psychologist remained mute allowing the younger guards to mock me in the hearing.

A mentality of "One Size Fits All," places elderly and vulnerable prisoners in harms way housing us in a cell/pod with little consideration to compatibility; see 18 August 2024 letter to CDCR/Ombudsman. All too frequent elderly/vulnerable prisoners are placed in a cell/pod with predatory/bully prisoners only to be fodder to these younger ageist prisoners. Complaining to guards it is not uncommon to receive feckless replies like: "What do you expect me to do about it?" "Deal with it." "Man-up." etc.

Too many elderly/vulnerable prisoners have fallen serious victims due to staff indifference. There needs to be more officers amongst guards.

This letter and support documents are sent open, knowing disclosures in CDCR have a way of dissolving into the prison labyrinth and at 80yrs old in the denouement of my life I want my survivors, and anyone who may care, to know how CDCR killed me and other elderly prisoners.

In your reply, please do not send me more pamphlets how I should file a 602. The accompanied documents includes a HQ Denied 602 true to the paper wall CDCR uses to wear down abused prisoners. Prisoners who carry their struggle into the court system are hobbled by the Prison Litigation Reform Act (PLRA) that discourages personal attorneys. Thereby encountering the power of the Attorney General's Office, and a scenario where David rarely prevails over the Giant
CASE IN POINT:

Having survived a brutal forced transfer at Donovan S.P. the facts were brought to the Southern District Federal Court: OUTMAN vs PARAMO 3:18-cv-02101-BAS-KSG. Due to conditions of old age and lack of judicial sophistication in 2020 the suit was dismissed "Without Prejudice" allowing CDCR to continue their stressful abuses.

Ms LaPurja, with these disclosures, and others not mentioned, I/we ask your firm to protect the most vulnerable class of prisoners and stop the state sanctioned elder abuse.
