

Whitey Bulger Update

Here's an interesting experience. The attorney representing the alleged mafia hit man who allegedly killed Whitey Bulger wrote me. His letter's attached.

When the investigator, a retired FBI agent, came to see me, he told me that the B.O.P. forged medical records of Whitey to enable them to ship Whitey to the prison where Whitey was killed within 24 hours.

Staff put Whitey in a cell with a Black guy (a huge No-No in the feds), who, the next day, left the cell. A couple minutes later the three sicilian guys went in, stayed for 10 minutes, then left.

It could be that the Black


