On November 15, 2023 at approximately 1030 Richard J. Donovan Correctional Facility (RJDCF) experienced a Power outage to the Institutional main transformer, resulting a loss of power to Facilities A,B,C,D affecting all Housing Units from the respective Facilities November 16, 2023.

MOVEMENT: Facilities A, B, C, and D, Housing Units will provide direct observation during escorts and all Inmate Movement shall be controlled. Inmates will wear State Blues while being escorted for all Priority Ducats and Medication Pill Distribution.

FEEDING: Cell feeding for Facilities A, B, C and D. Echo Facility will be normal.

VISITING: Visiting for Facility A, B. C, and D will be cancelled including Family visiting. Echo Facility will have normal visiting.

LEGAL VISITS: Urgent/emergency, via telephone or video conference where available. Board of Parole Hearings will continue with attorney contacts as required for Facilities A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will have normal legal visits.

WORKERS: Critical Workers only for Facilities A, B, C, and D. Critical Central Kitchen workers ONLY on Facility A. IWL Critical workers ONLY on Facility D. Critical HFM workers from Facility A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will be normal.

SHOWERS: Facilities A, B, C, and D will have no showers. Echo Facility will be normal.

HEALTH CARE SERVICES: Facilities A, B, C, and D urgent and emergent ducats only, to include priority ducats identified by Health Care staff as urgent or emergent. Health Care staff shall pick up 7362 forms from Housing Units and confirm pick up by documenting in the Housing Unit logbook. Priority ducats only, urgent and emergent add-on will be accepted. Echo Facility will be normal.

MEDICATION(s): Inmate movement shall be controlled one Housing Unit at a time to prevent any passing of contraband, unless security would dictate. Movement will be in such a fashion as to not mix inmates from other Housing Units. Medication distribution for Housing Unit 9 will be distributed cell side by Health Care Access Staff. Echo Facility will be normal.

MENTAL HEALTH: Emergent consults will be conducted cell side. Mental Health staff will see emergent consults from the Housing Units for Facilities A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will be normal. Recreational Therapy Yard will be suspended for Facilities A and C. Echo Facility will be normal.

LAW LIBRARY: Cancelled for Facilities A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will be normal.

EDUCATIONAL/ISUDT MATERIALS: Education assignments and ISUDT will be cancelled. Echo Facility will be normal.

DAYROOM: Dayroom activities will be suspended on Facilities A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will be normal.

RECREATION: Recreation will be suspended on Facilities A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will be normal.

GYMNASIUM: There will be no Programs in the Gymnasium for Facilities A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will be normal.

CANTEEN: No Canteen for Facilities A, B, C and D. Echo Facility will be normal.

LAUNDRY: Laundry Staff will coordinate with warehouse personnel to accommodate laundry exchange on Facilities A, B, C, and D.

RELIGIOUS SERVICES: Shall be conducted inside the cells for Facilities A, B, C, and D. Echo Facility will be normal,

REQUEST FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES FORMS: Health Care will conduct rounds to distribute and collect all 7362's for Facilities A, B, C, and D in the Housing Units during second watch. Rounds shall be documented in the Housing Unit log books by Health Care Staff.

The Program Status Report will be evaluated and updated daily.

REMARKS: Effective November 28, 2023, due to threats on the facility and dangerous contraband discovered, Institutional program shall be modified pending completion of essential searches.

MOVEMENT: All movement of Facility C inmates shall be under direct escort in restraints. Unclothed body searches shall be conducted on Facility C for all movement prior to exiting their cell. Inmates shall be processed through the housing unit metal detector and/or hand held metal detector. In the event an inmate does not clear the aforementioned detecting methods, the inmate shall be scanned utilizing the low dose scanner.

when leaving and returning to the Facility.

All inmates leaving Facility C via ETV/911 shall have an unclothed body search prior to entering the ETV.

Facility A, B, D, and E normal movement.

RECREATION: No recreation Facility C all other facilities normal.

WORKERS: No workers on Facility C. All other Facilities normal

HEALTH CARE SERVICES: Urgent and emergent ducats only Facility C, as identified by health care. Facility A, B, D and E all Priority ducats. Escorts to and from ducated appointments shall be HCA staff and designated Facility staff. Health Care staff shall pick up 7362 forms from Housing Units and confirm pick up by documenting in the Housing Unit logbook.

MENTAL HEALTH: Mental Health programing will be completed cell side. 1 on 1 consults/Urgent and emergent add-ons are authorized for Facility C. All others normal.

CANTEEN: Facility D and E.

MEDICATION: Facility C medication distribution cell-front. Facilities A, B, D, E normal.

LAW LIBRARY: PLU and inmates with court deadlines will be verified by Education staff and paging system will be implemented to accommodate.

EDUCATIONAL/ISUDT MATERIALS: Education assignments and ISUDT will be suspended on Facility C. All other Facilities normal

VISITING: No visiting Facility C. All other facilities normal visiting.

**LEGAL VISITING:** Urgent/Emergent via telephone or video conference. Board of Parole Hearings will continue with attorney contacts as required.

SHOWERS: Every 72 hours
