history. They want me to die here for a murder I did not commit.

To answer your questions: 1) When you sent this Oct. 31, 2025 - I was in Ad Seg at E.H.D.C.C. - but, was transferred to S.E.C.C. on Nov. 12, 2025 and released to General Population where I was up until March 25, 2026.

2) I have nothing filed in court at present. I was in the process of drafting a Rule 91 State Habeas Corpus Petition to try to file in court pro se (i.e. w/out an attorney) - but, my legal documents/materials are in the Property Room here, and I am encountering difficulties from caseworker MR. Wright in obtaining it. I have written endless lawyers sending them my Actual Innocence Account and paramount evidentiary documents of (2) two eyewitnesses (identifying others as committing the murder) and an alibi witness (mandating I was at a party when the murder occurred) uncalled at trial, NOR investigated by trial counsel Laura O'Sullivan - and none want to accept my case pro bono (with-

out money). Also, I mailed it to the Midwest Innocence Project in Kansas City, MO, (whom has been reviewing my case files since 2018); the Innocence Project in New York, NY, (reviewing case files since 2020); and the Exoneration Project in Chicago, IL, (sent in questionnaire in 2024). Please understand that I have sent these orgs everything they have requested to-date — yet, none have accepted my case to represent me. I point out: my trial counsel Laura O'Sullivan done some work for the Midwest Innocence Project (back in 2013 or earlier) and may still be doing — so there may be a conflict or some stonewalling going on in my behalf.
