Summarize your issue or concern (1500 character limit): my issue is with the commutation, that the governor is granting. lifers have to serve 20 years (with a Class A felony, which carries a life sentence), but I served 26 years, (with 2 Class B felonies) and I am not eligible for the commutation, even though, I have served more time than the lifer. Please allow me to get this commutation. My sentence was too excessive anyway, so said anyone, even my attorney Dennis Schertz, he filed motions, in the trial court, court of appeals and Supreme court. All the courts denied the motions. The La Crosse Tribune ran a story on my case: headline read "Cold Hard Truth, when Judge Mulroy sentenced Childeric Maxy, he handed him a 60 years sentence, Mulroy knew he was giving him what amounted to a life sentence". I believe that I am a poster-child for this commutation. I have completed programs and received a total of 28 certificates or more, and have 2 college diplomas. I have worked for all the DAI institutions that I've been to, and DOC for 26 years. Please I pray that I am eligible for this historic commutation.
